## A Lift of Texables taking a Lift of Texables.

EIT ENCTED by the Kings most Excellent Majesty by & with the Advice and Consent of this present General Assembly and the Authority of the same, that from and aster the publication hereof every Constable within this Province shall at or before the 20th, day of June in every year respectively repair in per in to every respective house or habitation within his hundred, and there Eof the Master, Mistress, Dame or other chief person of the Family a true Lift from under their hands of all their taxable persons they and every of them Inve within their respective Familys, out of which List the said Constable shall make two fair fair Lifts under his hand, and one he shall fend to the Sherrif of the County, and the other he shall present to the next County Court to be set up, and if in case any Master, Mistris, Dame or other chief person of a Family shall resuse or deny to give fuch Lift, or in their ablence leave at their dwelling houses or quarters such a List and Account of their taxable persons of their several Familys, or in the faid account shall conseal any raxable person or persons in his or their Family, for every such offence not giving a true list and account of them to the Code. Itables by the time required, and for every taxable person by them concealed shall. forfeit and pay for every such offence the sum of five hundred pounds of tobacco for every person to by him or them conceased, & every Constable mered ing his office herein, stall soricit and pay the sum of sive hundred pounds of the second for every such offence, one half thereof to his Majesty his Heirs and Successors for the Support of Government, the other half to the informer or him or them that will fue for the same, to be recovered in any Court of Record within this Province, wherein no Elloyn Protection of Wager of Law to be allowed.

And Be it further Enacted by the Authority aforefaid. Sc. if any inhabitant within this Province, shall from the time herein appointed for taking the list of taxables, on the last day of July purchase any taxable person or persons, he or The shall with all convenient speed give notice of the said taxable or taxables to the Constable of the said hundred, who is hereby injuyated to give account to the next County Court, and to the end that no person for the suture may be ignorant

Be in Enacted by and with the Advice and Consens aforesaid, that all Male Children born within this Province and resident in it shall be taken and accounted taxables at the age of fixteen years and upwards, and all Male Children Servanis imported into this Province at the age of fixteen years and upwards thall be accounted taxables, and all Slaves whatfoever either Male or Female imported into or born in this Province at or above the age of fixteen years shall be accounted taxables and so rated, and that all Freemen within this Province (except Clerky Men and likewise such poor impotent persons that receive Alms from the sounty.) shall be accounted taxables being above the age of fixteen years.
