An All for the due Recording of all Laws of this Province to the Secretarys Office, as also transnistting the Journal of the house of Delegates into the Secretary's Office.

EITENACTED by the Kings molt Excellent Majolty by and with the Advice and Consent of this present General Assembly and the Authority of the lame, that the Secretary of this Province in whole cultody the Records remain, do it or besote the centh day of March next cause all frich Laws and Acts of Anembly as mali be offorce at the end of this profest Sellions of Allembly to be acres upon Record in a large new Book of a large Folio and good and fub-Rantial Paper well bound, either in Leather or Parchment to be writtin a fair legible hand, as also all other Laws hereafter to bomade within fix Months after any Sethons of Affembly that shall hereaster happen, to be kept in the Secretarys Ofthe Covernour has affixed the broad Seal, and the fame to the figured by the Honourable the Sccretary and sealed with the lesser Seal, and that his Homount the Secretary cause a List or Catalogue of the said Laws to be entred in the faid Book, and an Index or Table directing to every Act in the same, and in default thereof by the time aforefaid, shall pay as a Fine for the same the sum of ten thousand pounds of robacco, to be recovered in his Majestys name, the one half to his Majeity for the support of Government, the other half for him or them that shall she for the same, and when the same is written and done, the said Secretary foall at the next General Assembly be allowed and paid out of the publick Leavy To much as the faid Secretary shall reasonably deserve.

And Be it further Enacted by the Authority aforefaid, that the Clerk of the House of Delegates for the time being transcribe the Journal of the faid House within two Months after the Prorogation or Dissolution of any Assembly now held or to be held hereaster, upon penalty of five hundred pounds of tobacco, to he forferred and said to our Sovereign Lord the King one half of which Fres for the suppert of Government, and the other half to him or them that shall fue for the same, to be recovered in any Court of Record within this Province by Bill, Plaint or In-

formation, wherein no Essaya Protection or wager of Law to be allowed.

As All for securing Merchants and others tobacco after they have received it.

EITENACTED by the Kings most Excellent Majesty by and with the Advice and Content of this prefent General Assembly and the Authorty rif the same, that from and after the publication hereof, every Housekeeper and in habitant within this Province having a Plantation whereon he maketh or causeth to be made any cobacco, thall build and creek, or otherwise fit up and make ready a good tight liquite, with a good Door Lock and Key upon every Platation where then rebacco is made as atorefaid, and fufficient to contain the tobacco made on e-

unly Pagintion. And the it further Enasted by the Authority aforefaid, that every luhabitant or Housekeeper as aforciaid, having a Plantation whereon he maketh or causeth to to made any tobacco as aforefuld, and that shall pay away and dispose of any tebe co to any Merchant, Matter of Ship or Sailor or any other person whatsoever, thall mass tin landing fach dispotore or payment, fecure and keep the faid tobacco and a would do his own proper Goods for and during the space of one whole year, commencing from the rand of reactiving the subacto and no longer; and if any tobut on to exercised as affereited for the want of fuch noute as aforefaid should be damnified or thole, the perion neglecting to provide fuch house shall make satis-Adding to the party thre received the fame.

Fronted the systemat nothing in time Act contained that the conftruct meant & specified to make any Inhobitant or Housekeeper lyable to any damage which that is may trapped to any tobacco to left with him to keep fecure through any .
