An All for regulating of Ordinarys; and limitting the number of them with A STATE OF

OR the better regulating Ordinary Repers & Inholders within this Province for the future BEIT EN AGIND by the Kings most Excellent Majorty by and with the Advice and Confent of this profent Goneral Assembly & the Authority of the lame, that from and after the publication hereof, the Commissioners of each County Court, and the Mayor Recorder and Aldermon of the City of St Marys at the Mayors Court, beand are hereby impowered and authorized from time to time as often as need shall require to grant Licences to such person & perfons as they shall think fir to be Ordinary keepers and Inholders for the keeping of Onlivarys and shoules of entertainment; fo long time as in fuch and fo many places within their leveral and respective Countrys and City aforesaid, for the cale and conveniency of the Inhabitants, Travellers and Strangers as to them respectively shall feem meet, for which Licences the said persons that shall be so licensed to keep Ordinarys, except all fitch persons as shall keep Ordinary or Ordinarys in the Pert of Annapolis in the County of Ann-Arundel, shall at the time of his or their taking such Licence or Licences be bound & oblig'd co pay unto the Secretary of this Province for the time being if he or they keep Ordinary within the Port of Annapolis in Ann-Arundel County or within two miles thereof the sum of two thousand pounds of tobacco yearly for a fine for every such Licence, or is he or they do keep Ordinary within the City of St. Marys, or at any County Court House, or at the Town and Port of Williamstadt within this Province the sum of twelve hundred pounds of tobacco, and if any person or persons shall keep any Ordinary or houses of enterta inment in other remoter parts, for entertainment of travellers shall pay to the said Secretary for the time being yearly for a fine the fum of four hundred pounds of tobacco and no more, and give Bond for the payment thereof.

And it is hereby Enacted by the Authority, aforefaid, by and with the Advice and Consent aforesaid, that the Clerk of each respective County Court within this Province, and the Clerk of the Mayors Court of the faid City of St. Marys shall cause such Licence and the fines for granting such Licences and the security. given for the payment and performance thereof, to be duly entred upon Record in their feveral Courts, and then transmit the said Bonds to the suffices of the Provincial Court for his Majetty's faid Secretarys use, for which said Licence and Bonds such Ordinarykeepers thall pay to such relocative Clerk sixty pounds ofte-

bacco and no more.

And Be it further Enacted by the Authority aforefaid, Ge, that the Committee oners-of the feveral County Courts; and the Mayor, Recorder and Aldermen of the faid City be and are hereby authorized & impowered at their several Councy Courts and Ma 3 ors Court in the Month of January and the Month of August half yearly and every year during the continuance of this Act, having fummoned each respective Ordinarykeeper within their respective County's and City, then & there to set and a Toss the Rates and prices of all liquois whatsoever in this present Ace not hereafter mentioned by them the faid Ordinarykeepers vended or to be vended for the year enfuing, and to for every year during the continuance of this Act, which races and prices to to be fet & afferfed, limited & appointed by the Commissioners aforesaid, and by the Magistrates of the Cuy aforesaid, shall be by their feveral and respective Clerks transcribed and for up at their several and respective County Courts and City aforefaid, in some publick place or places there, that overy person or persons may peruse the same, the Copy of which table and prices of liquors every Ordinarykeeper within each County are hereby obliged to rrantembe fairly and keep the fame fer up in the most publick place of their house oc houses for the perulai of all perions that receive any Ordinary accommodations from them, under the penalty of one thousand pounds of tobacco; to be applied to the use of the County where such Ordinarykeeper shall live, to be sued for in tale of non payment thereof in his Majestys name, for which sums and table of prices every Ordinary keeper thall pay to fuch Clerk the fum of forty pounds of tubacco and no more. And any Ordinarykeeper and Inholder that shall after the fetting and affeiling the rates and prices aforelaid, directly or mairectly take, exact, de-
