THE Condition of the above Obligation is such that if the above bounden A B do well and truly serve her said Majesty her Heirs & Successors in the Office of high Sherwithin the Province aforesaid and also shall reader unto her if of the County of faid Majelly & other her Officers a true faithful & perfect account of all & singular her ' faid Majeltys rights & dues and to her Officers a true & just account of their Fees that he shall or may be intrusted with by her Majestys Governour and other her Officers within this Province to receive & collect and his Account to her said Majesty her heirs and Successors and to her & their Governour there for the time being for the Fines and Forseitures & other dues belonging to her said Majestys Governour as also his account of all Fees Dues and Sums of Money or Tobacco for Levys or Fees due to any her Majellys Officers and other good people within this Province shall pass an account of by the tenth day of April next ensuing the date hereof and in all other things as Sherif shall behave himself well and honestly towards all persons acof the County of cording to the best of his power skill and knowledge, then this Obligation to be void and of no Effect or else to stand in full Force Strength & Vertue.

Which faid Bond taken in form aforefaid if by the County Court the Commissioners thereof thall transmit the same into the Secretarys Office together with all former Sherifs Bonds by them taken and the said Commissioners are hereby required and injoyned to take new security yearly and every year of such Sherifs to long as they shall continue in the said Office having a special regard not to admit any person to be security as aforesaid but such as are good and substantial Freeholders within their Countys, and also to make the Obligation of such Bond so to be from any Sherif answerable to

the publick charge of their tespective Countys.

And for incouragement of such persons now bearing or that shall hereaster bear the Office of sherif and who shall pun Rually comply with the publick Creditors it is also hereby surther Enacted by the Authority Advice & Consent aforesaid, that it shall and may be lawful for her Majestys Governour for the time being where no just complaint is made against such Sherifs to continue and make good their Commission

for the time & term of three years successively but no longer.

And Be it further Enacted by the Authority Advice & Consent aforesaid, that from and after the End of this present Sessions of Assembly every person or persons within this Province which are taxable within the several and respective Countys thereossiball and may by force & vertue of this Act at any time or times between the laying of the County Levy and the five and twentieth day of December then next ensuing pay his or their Levy or Levys in Money or so much thereos he or they shall please or think sit after the rate of one penny per pound for Tobacco, and the several and respective Sherifs of this Province are required by this Act to receive the same accordingly

Provided always that when such person or persons shall pay Money instead of To-bacco for his or their Levy or Levys as aforesaid and shall not pay and discharge the whole Sum of Tobacco with which he or they stand charged for his or their Levys by mony but shall leave some part thereof still due & owing in Tobacco such part so lest due in tobacco shall not be so broken that the Sherif cannot receive the same entire in a hogshead or hogsheads the quantity of sive hundred pounds of Tobacco being so ac-

counted.

And be it Enacted by the Authority aforefaid by and with the Advice & Confent aforefaid, that the several & respective Sherifs of the several & respective Countys within this Province shall & may after the End of this Sessions of Assembly by Force and
Vertue of this Act pay & discharge proportionably to what he shall receive in money
and not more, Officers Fees and Allowances made to any person or persons what for
ver in the Publick or County Levys in Money after the rate of one penny par pounds
for Tobacco.

Provided always that when such Sherif or Sherifs shall pay Money instead of the co to any person for his allowance in the Publick or County Levy and shall not pay discharge the whole Sum of Tobacco due to such person in money at the rate alorestic but shall leave some part thereof still due and owing in tobacco, then and in every such
