And whereas fevital ill minded people inhabiting & residing at the head of the Bay have commonly fee persons over the head of the Bay & Sulquehannah River being either Lelons Debtors or Runaway servants from the more remote parts of this Province for fome finall advantage they have in buying or gerting fuch Mony G ods or Apparel as fuch perions to ablencing or flying from utice aforeign have with them is ierally Momy Goods of Apparel by them felomoully purloyed from their Ma icrs & other Owners by which means they may mere daily travel to any other Government in retardate on of ju lice and to the great damage of fuch Creditors Maders or Owners aforefail.

Be it therefore Enadica by the Authority aforelaid by & with the Advice and a onfent aforesaid, that from & after the publica con hereof no person or persons inhibiting or being at the head of the Bay or in any other part of this Province shall transport or convey or caute to be transported or conveyed over Sufquehannah River aforefaild or any other part of the Bay above the North fide of Salfafras Piver on the Salfern Shoar of the Bay or over Potomock or Pocom ke Rivers into the Colony of Vinginia nor haveing Pa les so procured as aforesaid, or a Cer incate from under the hands of two tulisces of the Peace of the County where such person or persons intending to travel dall inhabit and the County Scal affix d thereto certifying the freedom of fuc i perfons, and that he she or they are clear to the best of their knowledge from any ingagements impeding their travelling as aforefuld on penalty of answering all fuch debts or damages to Creditors Matters or other Owners of ervants to he recover'd as by this Law is provided against fuch as shall a tually fet them out of this Province.

And be it further ina ted by the Authority Advice & onfeat aforefail that wharfoever person or virtons shall from henceforth indica transport or privarily carry or and away out of this Province any Apprentice hired or other servines or I vis the ongoing to any Inhabitant in this Province that i for every fuch offene forter and pay to the Imployer of Owner of fuch Apprintic hired or other 3: vint or 3 vetr hie dame is & consto he adjunged by the lutices of each respective from y Court or the firms of the Trevin ial Court for the time of fush Apprentices in tell or other Servanes or Slaves

unlawfully being transported or carry'd away as aforciaid.

An Act relating to Servants & Slaves.

HEREAS there have been fivera. Acts provided again? Servants Runn-aways which have here to proved the featual in regard they do not sufficiently provide incouragement for such person or persons Inhabitants of this Province as should forze fich Runaways or Servines by this AR deem I Runaways therefore for the better discovery seizing & app chending such Bunaways.

Be it Enacted by the Queens most excellent Majesty by & with the Advice & Con-Sent of her Maje lys Governour Council & Allembiy of this . rovince & h: Authority of the same, that from & after the publication hereof no servant or Services whatseewithin this l'rovince whether by Indenture or according to the cultom of the Count try or hired for Wages shall travel by Land or Water ten Sules from the House of his her or their Master Mi ress or Dame without a Noat under their hands or under the Multiplicated to the hand of his of their Overfeer if any be under the penalty of being taken for a Rumaway and to fuffer fuch penaltys as are hereafter provided again't Runaways. And

It is hereby further Enasted by the Authority Advice & Consent storesaid, that any S rvant or Servants unlawfully absenting him her or themselves from his her or their faid Master Mistress Dame or Oversecr shall serve ten days for every one days abtence and that latisfie or pay to his her or their Master Mi iref or Dim all such co to an I charges as 'hall be laid out & expended by his her of their hafter filtreis or Dime fir their taking up by fervitude to be adjudg'd when such Master Mistress or Dome stall bring their faid ervant before the Judices of the Provincial or Country Court where the Owner Master Mistress Dame or Overfeer of such servant shall live ouring the sitting of the fourt be it before or after the expiration of such Servants first u.m. of servicede by Indenture or otherwise.

And we it further Ena Ted by the Authority Advice & Consentasoresaid, that any person or persons whatsoever that shall wittingly or willingly entertain any such Seryour or Servants unlawfully absenting him her or themselves as aforesaid shall be fin'd five hundred pounds of Tobacce for every Night or twenty four Heurs that such perfon or persons shall give entertainment to such Servant or Servants unlawfully absenting him her Strihemselves as aforesaid, the one half ro her Majed v her Heirs & Succesfor the tapport of Government and the other half to the Informer or him or them
