And to prevent the abusing hunting or worying of any stock of Hoggs Cattle or Horses with Doggs or otherwise, Be it Enacted that if any person or persons whatsoever that have been convicted of any of the crimes aforesaid or other crimes of evil same fout fonce de carry a Gunn upon any persons Land whereon there shall be a seated Plantation without the owners leave ha-Ving been once before warn'd shall forseit & pay one thousand pounds of Tobacco one half to our Sovereign Lady the Queen her Heirs and Successors the other half to the party greived or those who shall sue for the same to be recover'd as aforesaid.

And the better to imprint the pains & penaltys of this 1.aw into the Minds of all forts of people and to prevent the committing any fuch crimes & o lences aforefaid.

Be it also Enacted that this Act shall be publickly read sour times a year in every Parish Church of this Province at the time of a full Congregation eitner before or after Service by the Clark or Reader of fuch Church under the penalty of 1000 pound, of tobacco forsciture to our Sovereign Lady the Queen her Heirs & Sunce for the ute of the parish to be paid or recover'd of every such Clark or Reader so negle ling.

And be it knacked by the Authority Advice & Confent aforefaid, that every Clark of the sev'ral & respective County Courts of this Province be & are hereby obliged ex officio to deliver to the sev'ral Clarks of their Parishes within their County's a fair copy
