And that the sev'ral and respective Naval Ossicers of the sev'ral & respective Ports may & are hereby authorized & impower'd when & as often as he or they shall think Trover fit to enter into any Ship or Vessel trading to and from this Province or into any house warehouse or other building and open any trunck chest cask or fardle and to search to make in any part or place of such Ship or Vessel Houses or Buildings as aforesaid where fuch Naval Officer shall suspect any Furrs or Skins to be as aforefaid for which no account is given or duty paid as aforefaid, and upon finding any fuch furrs & skins unqualified for exportation as aforefold them to feite and have condemn'd as by this Law is before directed.

And Be it further Enacted by the Authority aforefaid by & with the Advice & Confent aforesaid, that from & after the publication hereof as aforesaid all persons not being inhabitants of this Province exporting out of the same any Pork Beef or Bacon thall pay unto her Sacred Majosty her Heirs & Successors sor the use in this Act before & mention'd & exprest the sev'ral imposts following (that is to say) for dry'd Boef and Bacon twelve pence the hundred weight and so proportionably for any greater or lesier quantity, and for Pork & Beef undry'd twelve pence the Barrel each Barrel to contain two hundred weight, & that no undry'd Beef & Pork be exported our of this Province but in cask as aforefaid, which faid fev'ral impositions shall be collected and gathered by the feviral & respective Naval Officers who shall be accountable for the same as aforetaid and have full authority to enter any Ship or Vessel as aforesaid and to make fearch for any such goods as aforesaid in such method & manner as in this Act is before mentioned and express.

And if any person or persons being non residents as aforesaid shall put on board any Ship or Vettel any Beef Bacon or Pork for which he the or they shall not have a Certificate as aforefaid, or that shall ship on board any Beef or Pork undry'd not being in cask as aforefaid, fuch perfon or perfons to offending shall forfeit und lose all his her or their meat to shipp'd as aforestid one half to her Majesty her Heirs & Successors to the use aforetaid, and the other half to the informer to be recover'd as aforetaid.

And ev'ry Master of a Ship or Vessel that shall wittingly or knowingly take on board his faid Ship or Veffel any Beef Bacon or Pork contrary to the true intent & meaning of this Act being thereof legally convict shall forfeit and pay the Sum of five thousand pou de os tobreco one half thereof to her faid Majesty her Heirs & Successors for the use aforesaid the other half to the informer or him or them that shall sue for the same to be recover'd as aforefaid.

And for the better understanding what persons shall be adjudged non Residents, It is hereby Declared and Enacted by the authority advice & consent aforesaid, that all per-10ns whatfoever trading to & from this Province shall be adjudg'd deem'd & taken as non Residents not having a seated Plantation of sisty Acres of Land at the least where he she or they with their family (if any) have resided for and during the space of one whole year, and that within the time and term of twelve Months before any benefit claim'd by vertue of this Act, or that hath or hereafter shall have an house in some Port or Town as his or their proper Freehold being forty Foot in length and twenty foot in breadth with two Brick Chimneys to the same wherein he she or they shall have resided for and during the space of one whole year as aforesaid, and that no such person or persons trading to & from this Province having houses in any cown or Port within the same whereby he she or they may claim any benefit or freedom in this A& given to the inhabitants thereof thall have hold or enjoy such benefit and privilege as aforsaid any longer than he she or they or his her or their family shall in such Port & Town actually inhabit & relide.

Provided allways, and it is the true intent & meaning of this Act that no person of ways me persons whatsoever as shall tradedirectly from England to this Province as aforesaid be deem'd contrued reputed or taken as Foreigners but that all & every such person or Just persons to trading directly from Empland to this Province as aforesaid have free liberty 16. in the exportation of any Skins or Furrs what soever or in the Exportation of any meat dry'd or undry'd equal with the inhabitants of this Province paying such dutys & im-
