politions for the faid sev'ral & respective commoditys as this Law hat! imposed upon the inhabitants aforesaid and no more.

And be it also surther Enacted by the authority aforesail by & with the Advice and Consent aforesaid, that one former Ast of this Province Intituled an Ast for laying an imposition upon several Commoditys exported out of this Province be and is hereby repealed. Provided allways, and it is the true intent & meaning of this Ast that no person or persons whatsoever having in any part transgress diagainst the aforesaid Law during the time it was in sorce being as yet undiscovered or unprosecuted for the same or under present prosecution for the same shall have & receive any benefit or advantage by the repeal thereof but that upon the prosecution or discovery of such person or persons so having offended as aforesaid the said Law shall be pleadable in any Court within this Province wherein any Plaint or Information is or shall be brought again to such person or persons as aforesaid and the sudgment thereupon given by the saturds of the said Court as the nature of the cause shall require in as still & ample manner as thos the said Law at the time of the rendring such Judgment were than a study in sorce any thing before mention'd or recited to the contrary thereof netwith landing.

An Act for incouragement of Tillage and Relief of poor Deliers. DE it Enasted by the Queens most Excellent Majesty by & with the Advice & Confent of her Majelys Governour Council & Allembly of this Province and the Authority of the same, that every person or persons inhabitants of this Province who after the End of this Sellions of Assembly shall be indebted to any person or perfons whatfoever inhabitants of this Province in any fum or fums of Mony or quarries of Tobacco by Bond Bill Book Debt or Account or that shall have any Judgment or Judgments given & entred against them in any Court of Record within this Province ic fiall and may be lawful for such Debtor or Debrors respectively to pay and discharge themselves from such Debts & Judgments when they have not the specie for which the faid ludgments were given by the fev ral things following being of the growth & production of this Province, (that is to fay) Beef in well feafon'd cask tared and the tare on the head fett merchantable and well faved at three half pince per pound, Pork in well season'd barrells or other eask tared and the tare on the head sett merchantable of well faved at two pence per pound, Bacon at three pence half penny per pound, deved Beef at three pence per pound, Wheat at three hillings & fix pence per bulkel. Oa's at two shillings per bushel, Barly at two shillings per bushel, Indian Corn at one shilling & eight pence per bu hel, Peale at three shillings and six pence per bu hel. Beans at two thillings & fix pence per builtel, and the prizes of the aforefaid commoditys shall be ruted in Tobacco at the rate of one penny per pound as they are before rated, & the creditor & creditors of fuch debtor & debtors are by this A T injoyn'd & requir'd to accept and take fuch comn o livys or any of them of their debtor or debtors in full difference of the faid Debts and Judgments if tendred and paid at any one convenient place in the County.

And be it further Ena Acd by the Authority Advice & Confent aforefaid, that in case any creditor or creditors who shall have Judgment or Judgments again? any debtor or debtors and shall refuse to accept & take from his or their debtor or debtors such commoditys being of he growth of this Province as aforesaid in satisfaction of the Judgment or Judgments aforesaid but shall sue out Executions against the debtor or debtors upon the Judgment or Judgments aforesaid and imprison the debtor thereon, then it shall & may be lawful to for the Sherisin whose custody the debtor is, & such Sheris is by this Act required to receive take of such debtor his prisoner the several commodities by aforesaid or to many of them being of the growth of this Province as the said debtor his prisoner shall offer to him to the full value of the debt & costs and shall forthwith set at large and discharge the said debtor from his imprisonment, and such creditor or creditors shall have no other. Action against such Sheris but for the commoditys so as aforesaid received paying to the Sheris his Fees for taking the said commoditys.

Provided that this Act nor any thing therein contain'd shall be adjudged to extend to Merchants Adventurers who trade from England hither nor to the payment of any Bill or Bills of Exchange between Planters and Merchants, but in all such cases they shall be as they wer before the making of this Act any thing in this Act to the contrary thereof in any wife notwithstanding.

This Act to continue for three Years & to the End of the next Sessions of Assembly, afthr the three Years.
