the Authority of the same, that from and after the publication hereof all Masters of Ships and Vellels or others importing Irish Servants into this Province by Land or by Water at the time of their Entry shall pay unto the Naval Officer for the time being be- in soil in your make to know the first shall be to the state of the stat longing to such Port or Place where they make their Entry the sum of twenty shillings sterling per pole towards the defraying the publick charge of this Province for every Irish servant so imported on penalty and sorseiture of sive pounds sterling per pole for inches. every servant so conceal'd ar the time of his Entry aforesaid, the one half thereof to be appropriated to the uses aforesaid the other half to the informer or him or them that shallsue for the same to be recovered in her Majestys name in any Court of Record within this Province by Action of Debt Bill Plaint or Information wherein no Essoyn Protection or Wager of Law to be allow'd.

And be it further Enacted by the authority advice & consent aforesaid, that for ev'ry Negro imported into this Province either by land or water, the importer or importers of fuch negro or negroes shall pay unto the Naval Officer aforesaid the sum of twenty shillings sterling per pole for the uses aforesaid on penalty & forseiture of five pounds pinally for emission sterling per pole for every negro keptback or unaccounted for to be apply'd for the uses flogrow

aforesaid and to be recover'd as asoresaid.

And be it further Enacted by the authority aforesald by & with the advice & consent aforesaid, that from & after the publication hereof all Masters of Ships or other Vessels that shall seither by Land or Water import any Rum Brandy Spirits or Wine into this get, att. Province shall pay unto the Naval Officer aforefaid where they make their Entry the fum of three pence per gallon for every gallon of Rum Brandy Spirits or Wine so imported into this Province as aforesaid to be apply'd to the uses aforesaid (Liquors from

England allways excepted.)

And be it further Enacted by the authority advice & consent aforesaid, that no Rum Brandy Spirits or Wine upon which the dutys aforesaid are assess'd shall be landed or put on shoar out of any Ship or other Vessel which shall import the same or any other culty, upon calk in the without due entry thereof with the officer thereby appointed (upon Oath of the faid person or persons importing any of the asoresaid liquors) for collecting the same in the port or place where fuch liquors shall happen to be imported as aforesaid or before the how paie, ane and 12th dury due and payable for the same be satisfied or secured to be satisfied, and a warrant for the landing thereof be figured by the officer for that purpose appointed upon pain & peril that all fuch liquors landed & put on shoar contrary to the true intent & meaning towards the defraying of the publick charge of this Province and the other half to the of her Majestys Courts of Record within this Province by action of debt bill plaint or information wherein no Esloyn Protection or Wager of Law to be allow'd.

And for the better incouragement of all Masters Merchants Owners & other persons Whatfoever to make due entrys & payment of the dutys rates & impositions raised by this Act in consideration of leakage and other damage, the Officer is hereby authorized & impower'd to make allowance & abatement of twenty gallons in every hundred gallons of all such liquors so to be duly entred as asoresaid, and the Officers hereby appointed for collecting & gathering the dutys aforefaid shall & are hereby impower'd upon any suspicion of fraud or deceit by any importer owner or proprietor of any such liquors in concealing & not making due entry of the same to go and enter on board any Ship or Vessel or into any House or Warehouse on shoar & from thence to seize bring on shoar or secure all such liquors for which the dutys aforesaid are not duly paid of secur'd to be paid as aforesaid, & that the said Officers & their deputys may freely stay and remain on board until the goods are deliver'd & discharged out of the said Ship or Vessel, and all Officers as well military as civil of this Province and Masters & Officers of Ships are hereby required & injoyned to be aiding and affilting to fuch Naval Officers in discharging of their duty aforesaid, for all which the said Officers & others

assisting them shall be saved and kept harmless by vertue of this Act.

And be it further Enacted by the authority advice and consent aforesaid, that all such Naval Officers shall give good security to the Governour of this Province for the time being and shall take the several Oaths well & faithfully to gather the impost so arising by vertue of this Act or any clause herein contained and adjust & faithfully to account twice a year, and to give and render to the publick Treasurers of this Province for the time being authorized for receiving the faid impost for which the said Treasurers shall have for their fallary four pounds per Cent. who are to give good Bond for the fame to be accountable & render an account to the next meeting of the Assembly to be by theth disposed of towards the destaying of the publick charge of this Province.
