theriv of the same, that from & after the publication hereof the Juliers of each County be & are hereby impower'd & authorized from time to rime as often as need that require to grant Lycenfes to fuch perfor & perfors as they shall think it to be O heavy keepers & Inholders for the keeping of Ordinarys & Houses of Entertainment to long time and in such and so many places within their several & respective Councys for the case & conveniency of the inhabitants travellors and strangers as to them respectively shall seem meet, for which Lycenses the said persons that shall be so lycensed to keep Ordinary as aforefaid shall at the time of his or their taking fuch Lycenfes cover in a Recognizance to our Sovereign Lady the Queens Majeffy to pay unto her Milely towards the defraying the charge of the County the feveral & respective sums sollowing that is to fay, for every Lycense to keep Ordinary in the Ciry of St. Mirrs Towns & Ports of Annapolis & Williamstadt or at any County Court House within this Province the sum of twelve hundred pounds of Tobacco, and sour hundred pounds of robacco at every other place within this Province for every year such person shall keep Ordinary as aforefaid to the use aforesaid, for which said Lycense & Recognizance the party or party's taking the same shall pay to the Clerk of yach respective County Court the sum

of exty pounds of tobacco and no more.

And be it further Fnacted by the authority aforefaid, that the Judices of the favoral County Courts be and are hereby authorized and impower'd at their feveral County Courts in the Months of January & August yearly and every year having sum non. d each respe five Ordinary keeper within their respe Live Countys then & there to set & affest the rates & prices of all liquors and other accomodations whatforver by them the faid Ordinary keepers to be vended for the year enfuing & fo yearly & every year, which rates & prices of all liquors to to be let and a Tefs'd limited & appointed b. the Juilices aforefuld shall be by their feveral & respective Clerk's transcribed and fet up at their several & respective County Courts in some publick place there, that every parfon or persons may peruse the same the copy of which Table of prices of liquors & nocomodations e'ry Ordinary keeper within each County is hereby obliged to transer be fairly and keep the same set up in the molt publick place of their houses for the perulat of all perions that receive a ty Ordinary accommodations from them under the purity of one thousand pounds of tobacco to her Majedy her Heirs & Successors to be applyed to the life of the County where such Ordinary keeper shall live to be fund for on no 1 payment thereof in her Majedys Name, for which fummons and table of prices evira-Cidinary keeper shall pay to fach Clerk the sum of forty pounds of tobacco and an more, and very Ordinary keeper or Irholder that shall after the fitting up & a family the rates & prices aforetaid directly or indirectly take exact demand or receive for the price & pay for any fuch liquors or other accompditions for which the rates and prices I tall be fet & allefs'd as a ordfaid of any perfon or perfons, whatfoever above the rives and prices to fet & affets'd as aforefaid, shall for every such account to deformaking or received ferfeit and pay the fum of five hundred pounds of tobacco, one half thereof to her Majedy her Heirs and Successors for the use of the County, and the other halfro-Ism or them that shall inform or sue for the same and lose every such debt or account fined for taken or received fo unjustly charged exasted & demanded, the find forfeitures to be recover'd in any Court of Record within this Province by Bill Plaint or Information wherein no Effeyn i retection or Wager of Law to be allow'd.

And he it further knasted by the authority aforesaid, that every Ordinary knopper or Inholder to to be lycenfed as aforefaid shall within six Months after granting rheir tespective I veenses be hereby obliged to provide and maintain if they keep Ordinary at the Court House in any country or the Town and Port of Annancies and William tielt aforesaid six good and substantial Beds over and above what is for their own Familys use with sifficient warm covering for the same, together with accompdations of Oass Hay & Straw for Litter and Indian Corn with Stabling for twenty Horses ac leaft, and if any Ordinary be kept at any other place or part of the County than at the Court House such Ordinary keeper shall with a the time aforesaid he provided with sour spare Beds with c vering and sufficient Stabling & Provinder for six Horses at lea 1 under the penalty of five hundred pounds of tobacco, one half thereof to her Majefty her Heirs & Successors for the use of the Courty, the other half to him or them that shall inform or sue sor the same to be recover'd by Bill Plaincor Information wherein no Essoyn Pro-

tection or Wager of Law to be allow'd.

Provided allways that no person er persons so lycensed or to be lycensed to keep Ordinary as aforefaid shall during the time of fuch their keeping Ordinary be Delegates or Julices of the Peace for any County within this Province.

And he it further Enacted by the Authority aforefaid, that if any Ordinary keeper thall keep evil Rule in his house upon complaint made thereof to the Justices of the
