And be it further Ena ted by the Authority aforefaid, that any Ordinary keeper difabled or suppress d as aforesaid or any other person that shall presume to keep Ordi .: zy without Lycense art had & obrain'd as aforesaid hall for every Mo to be or they shall keep Ordinary as aforesaid for seit & pay two thousand pounds of Tobacco and 'o proportionably for a longer or shorter time that any person shall fell liquors or do co a trary to this Law, one half to her Maje by her Heirs & Successors for the use aforesa d & the other half to him or them that that! fue for the same to be recover'd in any Court of Record in this Province by Bill Plaint or Information wherein no Essoyn Protection or Wager of Law to be allow'd.

And be it further fin fell by the authority aforesaid that no person or persons inhabiting within this Province not having lawful Lycense shall sell by retail any Sider Quince drink or other firong liquors to be drank in his her or their houses or about his her or their Plantations upon forseiture of ev'ry time he she or they shall be legal ? convict thereof the fum of one thousand pounds of tobacco one half to her Majesty her Heirs & Successors for & towards the defraying the County charge where such forfeiture thall become due, and the other half to the informer or to him or them that shall tue for the fameto be recovet'd in any Court of Record within this Province by Action el Dobt Bill Plaint or Information wherein no Eisoyn Protection or Wager of Law to

be allow'd.

And be it further Ena ted by the authority aforefuld by & with the advice & confent aferefaid, that no perion or perions whatfoever to lycenfed to keep Ordinary as aforefaid thall roth is to credit any perfor capable of giving a vote for election of Delegates in any County within this Province to the value of four hundred pounds of tobacco per A mon for any accomodations by him vended whereof any furth person to capacitated as aforefried half have occasion of or require to be accomplated withall, under the nepalty or ferfeiture of four hundred pounds of tobacco by each Ordinary keeper forefufing to credit fuch perfor as aforefail, one movery thereof to her Mijely her Heirs & Succesions for & towards the defraying the County charge where fuch forfaiture hall become due, the other moyety to the informer or him or them that shall sue for the fame to be recovered as aforefaild.

And whereas it hath been found projudicial to the inhabitants of this Province that Ordinary konpers & inholders have frequently entertain'd divers Freemen & loofe per-I ms a great time tipling at their houses as well to the great damage of many persons as their own Ruin. Be it therefore had ted by the authority afortfaid by & with the advice & confent aforefaid that it hall not be lawful for any fuch Ordinary keeper or inholder to keep fach Ordinary or house of Entertainment until they have enter'd imp recognizative before the Judices of each respective Country granting fach licenses with tivo fullicem: furctys to the value of ewenty pounds Scotling that they shall not encertain any freemen or other look perfor above I wenty Four Hours (Court imes excepted) unless such person be capable to give his Vote for a Delegate in the faid County or that he be retain'd as a Servant to the faid Ordinary keeper or inholder, any Liv Oige or Culton to the contrary notwith landing.

And whereas and experience thems the great prejudice to the owners & Maters of Ships & Ve I Is trading into this Province by Ordinary keepers entertaining of Sailors & other ire fac's bios & Vedels belonging, and truiting & encouraging them to contime ripling in their houfes to the prejudice of trade within this Province preventing & impediate the dispatch of such Ships and Veisels, and very often when such Sailors

have them. They wages in fuch Ordinarys occasions & induces them to run away & defor the Sups & Vailels whereto they balong, for the prevention whereof

Be in the ded by the Queens most Excellent Majesty by & with the Advice & Con-Ent of her Maje lys i revernour Council & Affembly of this Province & the Authority Gibe same, that no Ordinary keeper whatfoever within this Province thall presume to burbour or enterrain fuch Sailors to the neglect of their service to their respective commonders and prejudice to the dispatch of any Ship or Ve lel thereby, under the pain & remains of being suspended from keeping such Ordinary, and that no Ordinary keeper Whitfoever shall credit any such Sillor for more than five shillings during any one Novage un for the penalty of loting his debt, and being fined to our Lady the Queen her Heirs & Successors the fun of five pounds sterling, whereof one half to the informor the other half to the Ve try of fuch Pari'h where fuch Ordinary keeper hall live towinds the defenying the Parith charges to be recovered in any Court of Record of this First by Bill Plaint or Information wherein no Efloyn Protection or Wager of Law
