(44) And lastly, it is hereby Enacted by the authority aforesaid by & with the advice & content aforesaid, that the Justices of the Provincial Court and the Justices of the respe-Aire County Courts shall give this Act in charge to the several Grand surve and to their several & respective Constables in their said Countys to inquire into the breach of this Act and into all disorders committed in the said Ordinarys and present the same if any be to the several Courts to be examind & punish'd according to Law. to endure for three Years and to the End of the next Seilions of Ailembly wdich sha's first happen after the end of the said three Years.

An Act ascertaining the heighth of Fences to prevent the evil occasioned by the multi-

tude of Horses and restraining Horse Rangers within this Province.

E it Enacted by the Queens most Excellent Majest v by and with the Advice and Consent of her Majesty's Governour Conneil and Assembly of this Frovince and the Authority of the same, that all inclosures by Fences or otherwise within the intentention of this Act hereafter mention'd shall be five foot high, and that from & after the first day of May till next the tenth day of November next and so yearly & every year all owners of any horse or horses mares colts and geldings shall and are hereby oblig'd to keep all such horse or horses mares colts or geldings within good and sufficient inclofures fenced grounds or pastures upon the pains & penaltys hereafter following.

Be it further Enacted by the authority afsd by & with theadvice & consentafsd, that if the owner or owners of any fuch horse or horses mares colts or geldings as asid shall omi: to take up drive in & keep up all fuch horses mares colts or geldings as are before mention'd or intended by default whereof any fuch horses mares coles or geldings hall break into the Pastures Cornfields or other Inclosures of any inhabitants within this Province within the time by this Act limited aforefuld the faid owner or owners thereo'having notice or warning thereof given him her or them two several times by the party greived and notwithstanding the owner or owners of such horse or horses mires coits or goldings as aforefaid shall negle 9 to perform what is by this Law injoyed and required, that then it shall & may be lawful for the person greived & dam nified to shoot kill or dellroy all or any fuch horse or horses marcs colts or goldings as aforesaid.

Provided allways, that no person wharsoever the grieved or damnified shall prefame to shoot kill or destroy any such horse or horses as aforesaid, except upon his her or their proper incloted ground within his her or their lawful possession by Leste for years, yearly rent or other lawful tenure upon the punity of paying the owner thereo the full value of fuch horse gelding mare or colt so kill'd or destroy'd to be recover'd by Action of trespass or Action on the case in any County Court of this Province.

And he it further Enasted by the Authority aforesaid, that if the owner or owners of any tuch harle horses mares colts or geldings shall not be known to the party or party s grieved or damnified as aforefaid, he the or they so grieved shall & are oblig'd with two stifficient evidences to take notice of the colour natural & artificial marks of any fuch horsemore coluor gelding in writing, and the same to assix and set up at the most publies, places within the County where fuch damage as aforefaid shall happen to be done for the tonic of one whole Month at the end of which no owner appearing it then hall & may be la viul for the partys grieved to shoot kill or destroy the said horse or horses upon his her or their Lands as aforesaid.

And he it further Enasted by the authority aforesaid by & with the advice & confent aforefaid, that whofoever shall unlawfully and without the knowledge & content of the owner take another Mans horse mare or golding, and the same keep one hour in his possession, and such Horse Mare or Gelding shall without consent atoresaid occupy in any labour or travail, shall not only pav dam mages to the owner, but shall forfeit & pay the sum of five hundred pounds of robacco, one half to the informer, the other half to the party grieved, to be recovered in any County Court of this Province by Action of debt bill plaint or information wherein no Essoyn Protection or Wager of Law to be allowed.

And forasmuch as divers complaints are made of the abuses committed by such perfons that have obtain'd Commissions from the Governour to range the Woods & Forrests after wild near cattle & horses, it is prayed that it may be Enacted, And

Be it Ena. 9cd by the Queens most Excellent Majesly by & with the Advice & Consent of her Majortys Governour Council & Assembly of this Province and the Authority of the same, that it shall not be lawful for any person after the end of this Sessions of Assembly to make application to the Governour for the time being to grant a Commission to range as aforesaid except such person produce a Cerrificate from under the hands of the suffices of the County Courts where the said person is to range setting forth that he is of good fame.
