And in vase the Secretary shall not pursue the directions of this Act but shall mak! default he hall forfeit the Sum of ten thousand pounds of Tobacco for every such neglect, the one half thereof to her Maje by for the support of the Government of this Province and the other half to him that will sue for the same to be recovered in any Court of Record within this Province by bill plaint or information wherein no enough

prote from or wager of Law to be allow'd.

And be it Enasted by the authority aforefail, that the Clerk of the House of Delegues for the time being hall transcribe the Journal of the fail House into a fair Book and in a good fair & tegrible Charaster within two Months after the end of each Settions and hall transmit the faine so transcribed int the Secretarys Office there to remain and the Secretary is required by this Ast to receive the same accordingly, and the Clerk making default shall forseit sive hundred pounds of tobacco for every offence the one half to her Majesty for the support of the Government of this Province, and the other half to him that will sue for the same.

And be it fina field by the authority aforefaid by with the advice & consent aforesd that the Secretary shall be allowed for Recording the said Acts in the Publick Levy so much as the General Allembiy shall think the said Secretary shall reasonably deserve.
