(56) "An Act for securing the Varochial Librarys of this Province.

Fit Enacted by the Queens most Excellent Majesty by & with the Advice and Consent of her Majertys Governour Council & Allembly of this Province and ne Authority of the same, that the Librarys appointed for the leviral & robe the Parillies within this Province thall be and remain in the hands & possession of the Minister of the Parish is there he any Minister astually inducted into and incumbent in the faid Parish during his residence in the said Parish, who is by this Act oblig'd to keep & preserve the said Library from wast & imbezlement and to be accountable for the saine to the Governour Council & Assembly as often as required.

And to that purpote the faid Minister shall pass two Receits for the said Books inserting what they are and the title page of the same one Receit to be by the Vestry of the hid parish transmitted to the Governour & Council and the other to remain with the Vellry of the faid parish to be enter'd in their Register Book, and the faid Veltrys are

hereby oblig'd to visit the faid Librarys twice in the year and inspect the same,

And in case the said Vestrys shall not (or at least four of them of eldest slanding shall not visit the said Librarys twice in the year as by this Act is required the whole number of Vellry-men shall sorseit & pay the Sum of sourceen pounds of Tobacco one moyery to her Majelly her Heirs & Successors for the support of Government the other moyery to the informer or him or them that shall sue for the same in any Court of Record in this Province by Action of Debt Bill Plaint or Information wherein no Effoyn Protection or Wager of Law to be allow'd and the ones probandi thall lie on the part of the Vellry to make it appear that they have visited the Librarys as by this Act they

And it is so happen that the Vestry sind any damage or imbezlement thereof they shall require and cause taxisfaction for the same to be made by Action of Debt to be blongar against the aid Minister his Executors or Administrators for the full value of auch Books as we or shall be wanting to be commenced and brought by the Vestrymen of his a respective parith where tach damage & imbezlement thall happen who by this As and imposized to bring their special Action without their Principal Vest yman.

A militable any Minliter having the charge of fuch Library thall be removed from I is elerge he hall deliver the faid Library to the Vestry of the said parish and make sasissa thos or inparation if any damage or wait fuller'd before his departure out of the faid parish (except by Fire or such unavoidable accident) or in case of the death of amy free Minister having the charge of such Library the Vestry of such parish shall immediany twe the faid Library into their cuflody and keeping and pass their receit for the fime as above directed and shall in all points be answerable for the same (except by fire or tich like accident as aforefaid.)

And for the better preferring and fecuring the faid Librarys it shall & may be lawful For his Excellency the Covernour of this Province for the time being to appoint one or more villions of the faid Library's within this Province to report the true Effate of them to his Excellency the Governour & Council that they may make Orders to cause ev'ry one contern'd about the faid Librarys to do their dutys to the effectual preferring of

An All reAraining the Entertions of Sherifs Subsherifs & Deputy Commissarvs. Thereas there have been divers great complaints from sevial parts of this Province to this General Assembly of sev'ral Sherifs Sub'herifs & deputy Commillions of their exacting & extorting great Sums of tobacco above their due & lavful i cos alcertain'd by the Act of Assembly of this Province from several of the inhabitants of this Province and tho' the Laws of this Province have inflitted a severe penalty upon any Officer that shall charge & receive more than his due Fees yet the said Officers have most cunningly & crastily evaded the said Laws by taking Bills or Writings obligatory without ever delivering any account fign'd under their hands as the Law directs io that the party griev'd can not sufficiently prove the said Extortion & so is lest without Pemedy for prevention whereof,

Bo it Enasted by the Queens most Excellent Majesty by & with the Advice & Consont of her Majestys Governour Council & Assembly of this Province & the Authority of the same, that no Sherif Subsherif or deputy Commissary within this Province after the publication of this Ach in their sevirall & respective Countys wherein they dwell ; shall take any Bond Bill or any other Writing obligatory of any person or persons upon any presence whatfoever without endorling the account on the back of the faid ond Bill or Writing obligatory for which the fame was pass'd and if any Sherif Subcrifor de vuty Committury within this Province shall during the time that he remains his place or office upon any presence whatfoever take any Bond Bill or Writing obstory wit Contendoring the account on the back of the faid Bond Bill or Writing
