F it Enacted by the Queens most Excellent Majesty by and with the Advice and Lead Consent of her Majestys Governour Conneil and Assembly of this Province and the Authority of the same, that whatsoever Popish Bishop Priest or Iesuit shall baptize any child or children other than such who have Popish Parents or shall say Mais or exercise the sunction of a Popish Bishop or Priest within this Province or shall endeavour to persuade any of her Majestys Leige People of this Province to embrace and be reconciled to the Church of Rome and shall be thereof legally convict shall forfeir the fum of fifty pounds flerling for ev'ry fuch offence the one half thereof to our Sovereign
