(59) to be taken by all Officers by the Acts of Assembly of this Prevince and the Oath of a

Tou A B shall well & truly serve our Sovereign Lady the Queen in the office of a Constable you fall see and cause that her Majestys peace be well & duly kept according to your power, you shall arrest all such persons as in your presence shall commit any Riot Fray or other breach of her Majestys Peace, you shall do your best endeavour upon complaint to you made to seize all felous harretors rioters or persons riotously asembled & if any such offender shall make any resistance with force you shall levy Flue & Cry and pursue them until they be taken, you shall do your best endetvour that Hue & Cry be duly raised & pursued against. Murtherers Thieves and other Felons & fugttiveServants and the Laws & Orders against Vagabonds and such other idle persons coming within your limits be duly put in execution at your County Courts coming you shall present all offences done against the several Acts made for the suppressing of drunkenness, and also true presentment make of bloodsheads aff rays outcryes rescues and other offences committed against ber Majestys Peace within your limits, you shall well & touly execute all Precepts & Warrants to you directed from the Justices of Peace of this County or higher Officers, and you shall well & truly according to your power knowledge & ability do & execute all things helonging to the office of a Censtable so long as you fall continue in this office. So help you God.

And if the person or persons so appointed shall besore any Justice of the Peace result to take the sev'ral Oaths aforesaid or shall tesuse to provide a sufficient person to supply his place by ferving in the faid office and taking the Oaths aforefaid, that then fuch person so resuling shall be fined to her Majesty in the sum of five hundred pounds of tobacco towards the defraying the publick charge of that County and that fuch Justice of l'eace before whom the refusal shall be made thall issue his Warrant to the Sherif to levy the fuid fine by diffress and fale of the goods & chattels of such person so fined as aforetaed returning the overplus which faid Sherif is hereby impower'd & requir'd to levy the tame accordingly and render an account thereof to the Justices of Peace of that

County at the time of laying the County Levy.

And be it Fnacted by the authority aforefaid by & with the advice & consent aforesaid, that ev'ry Constable shall on or before the 20th day of June in every Year respectively repair in person to every house or habitation within his Hundred and there inquire of the Maller Millress Dame or other chief person of the Family a true List from under their Hands of all their taxable persons they and every of them have within their respective lamilys out of which List the said Constables shall make two sair Lists under his hand and one he shall send to the Sherif of the County and the other he shall present to the next County Court to be ser up, and if in case any Master Mistress or Dame or other chief persons of a Family skall resuse or deny to give such List or in their absence seave at their dwelling houses or quarters such a List & Account of their taxable persons of their sev'ral Familys or in the said account shall conceal any taxable person or persons in his or their Family for every such offence or not giving a true list & account of them to the Constable by the time required and for every taxable person by them conceal'd shall forfeit & pay the sum of five hundred pounds of tobacco for every such offence one half thereof to her Majesty her Heirs & Successors for thesupport of Government the other half to the informer or him or them that will fue for the same to be recover'd in any Court of Record of this Province wherein no Esloyn Protection or Wager of Law to be allow'd

An Act requiring the Masters of Ships & Vessels to publish the rates of their Freight before they take any Tobacco on board.

DE it Enacted by the Queens most Excellent Majesty by & with the advice & con-I sent of her Majestys Governour Council & Assembly of this Province & the authority of the same that every Master & Commander of a Ship or other Vessel that pur poses to export tobacco on freight shall before he take any such tobacco on board his said Ship or Vessel publish in writing by a Note under his hand which he shall cause to be affix'd on the Ceurt House Door of that County where his said Ship skall ride at Anchor ar what rate he will receive tobacco upon freight per Ton on board his said Ship for that intended voyage which Note the Clerk of the County shall enter upon Record.

And be it further Enacted by the authority aforesaid that whatsoever Merchant or other inhabitant of this Province shall pur any tobacco on board any Ship Sloop or Boat belonging to a Ship on freight before such Master of such Ship hath set up such Note as aforesaid he shall forseit & lose all such tobacco so shipp'd on board such Ship Sloop or Boat or the full value thereof in money whereof one half to her Majesty for the support of the government of this Province the other half to him or them that will 'fue for the same to be recover'd in any Court of Record in this Province' by action of Debt Bill Plaint or Information wherein no Essoyn Protection or Wager of Law to be allow'd.
