And be it surther Enacted by the authority aforetesaid, that if any Master or Commander of Ship or other veilel as aforefd shall take any such tobacco on board his Ship or Vessel before he hath publish'd such Note as aforesaid he shall forseit for every such bogshead the sum of twenty Shillings to the uses aforesaid to be recover'd as aforesaid.

And be it further Enacted by the Authority aforesaid, that every Master or Commander of Ship or Vessel as aforesaid that shall send any Sloop or other Crast to another County to fetch tobacco to be put on board his Ship or Vessel on freight shall send by the Skipper or Master of such Sloop or other Crast a Certificate under the hand of the Clerk of the County where luch Note of Freight was publish'd as aforefaid certifying the rate of his freight and publication thereof as aforesaid under the penalty of forfeiting forty shillings verling to the uses aforesaid to be recover'd as aforesaid.

And the Collectors and Naval Officers shall at the charge of the County where such Collectors & Naval Officers inhabit procure copys of this Law for each copy whereof the County Clerk shall have ten pounds of tobacco and no more and affix the same in their Office or Offices on or before the tenth day of December next enfuing under the penalty of forty shillings sterling to be for such neglect forseited & paid to the uses a-

foresaid to be recover'd as aforesaid.

As Act for appointing Court days in each respective County in this Province. O the intent that Court Davs may be ascertaind and that the Commissioners

within their respective Countys may know when to attend.

Be it Enacted by the Queens most Excellent Majesty by & with the Advice & Consent of her Majettys Governour Council & Assembly of this Province & the Authority of the same, that for the suture St. Marys Baltemore & Dorchester County Courts shall be held the first Tuesday in September November January March June & Augnst, and Ann-Arundel Charles Somerset & Cacil Countys the second I uesdays in September Noremler January March June & August, and for Calvert & Tallet County's the third I uciday in September November January March June & August, and for Kent & Prince Georges Countys the fourth Tuelday in September November January March June and 447 B.

And he it Enasted by the authority aforesaid by & with the advice & consent aforefaid, that any two Juitices of the fer ral and respective County Courts whereof one of them to be of the Querum shall have full power and authority by vertue of this Act when and as often as need shall require to adjourn the said County Court and Process and Proceedings therein depending to such short time after as they shall see conveni-

An AA laying an imposition of three pence per bogshead on Tobacco for defraying the fullick charge of the Province.

E it Enacted by the Queens most Excellent Majesty by & with the Advice and Consent of her Majesty's Governour Council & Assembly of this Province and the Authority of the same, that from and after the End of this Se lions of Assembly a duty or imposition of three pence for every hogshead of tobacco and the like duty for ever y five hundred pounds of tobacco contain'd in chest box or case on all tobacco that shall be exported out of this Province by Land or Water be raised levy'd & paid to her Majesty towards the defraying the publick charge of this Province by all Masters of Ships and other Veilels trading into this Province in ready Mony and to be collected by the Naval Officer of the Port or District where such Ships or Vessels shall clear.

And the faid aval Officers are directed & required by this Act to receive the same in ready Mony accordingly, and the said Officers shall account & pay for the said imposition of three pence per hogihead & the three pence for every five hundred pounds of tobacco contain'd as above in ready Mony to the Treasurers of this Province who are hereby required to render an account thereof and pay the same in ready Mony to

the General Assembly.

And be it further Enacted by the authority aforefaid by & with the advice and confent aforesaid, that the said imposition of three pence per hogshead and three pence for every five hundred pounds of tobacco contain'd as abovesaid shall be appropriated by the General Assembly of this Province towards the paying of the publick charge thereof and to no other use whatfoever.

And be it further Enacted & Declared by the authority aforesaid by & with the Advice & Consent aforesaid, that if any tobacco should by any casual means be lost after the imposition paid that then and in all such cases the Owner or Freighter of all such tobacco shall have free liberty to freight and ship off the like quantity again without paying the said impostion. This Act to continue for three Years or to the End of the next Sellions of Atlembly which shall first happen after the said three Years.
