pounds of tobacco for one Year and so after that rate for a greater or lesser Snm or for 2 longer or thorter time, and that all Bonds Contracts & Assurances whatsoever made after the time aforefaid for payment of any principal Mony or Tobacco Goods or Commoditys asoresaid to be lent or covenanted to be perform'd upon or for any usury whereupon or whereby there shall be reserved above the rate of tix pounds in the hundred for Mony as aforesaid or above eight pounds in the hundred for I obacco or other Goods or Commoditys as aforesaid shall be utterly void, and that all & ev'ry per'on & persons whatsoever which after the time aforesaid shall upon any contract to be made take exact & receive by ways or means of any corrupt Bargain Loan Exchange Chieve zance shift or Interest of any Wares Merchandizes or other thing or things whatsoever or by any deceitful ways or means or by any covin Instrument or deceitful Conveyance for the forbearance or giving day of payment for one whole Year of and for their Mony Tobacco Goods & Commoditys aforesaid above the Sum of Mony or quantity of Tobacco aforefaid for the forbearance aforefaid shall forfeir & lose for every such offence the treble value of the Mony Tobacco Wares Merchandizes or other things fo lent bargain'd fold exchang'd & thifted as aforefaid the one half of the faid fine & forforseiture to our Sovereign Lady the Queen her Heirs & Successors for the support of this Government the other half to him or them that shall sue for the same to be recover'd in any Court of Record of this Province by Action of Debt Bill Plaint or Information wherein no Elloyn Protection or Wager of Law to be allow'd.

An Act alcertaining the Expences of the Councillors Delegates of Assembly & Commissioners of the Provincial & County Courts of this Province.

OR the afcertaining limiting & allowing unto the feveral & respective Council lors Deputys and Delegates that serve or shall serve in the Gen'ral Assemblys of this Province and of the sev'ral & respective Commissioners of the Provincial & County Courts of this Province such Sum & Sums of Yobacco as is hereby thought necessary and sufficient for their destraying their charges in attending such Assemblys and Courts.

Be it Fna fted by the Queens most Excellent Majesty by & with the Advice & Confent of her Majestys Governonr Council & Assembly of this Province and the Authority of the same, that all such Councilors be allow'd the Sum of one hundred and fif:y pounds of tobacco per day & the Delegates & Burgesses of Assembly shall be allow'd the firm of one hundred & forty pounds of tobacco per day during the time they shall attend such Assemblys and no more (besides their itinerant charges) to be paid & allowed them out of the publick Levy of this Province- and the feviral & respective Commi ileners of the Provincial Court for the defraying their charges and expences during the time they I all 1st in & attend such Courts the sum of one hundred & forty pounds of tobacco per day and no more (besides their itinerant charges) to be paid them likewife out of the publick Levy of this Province as aforefaid, and the fev'ral Commissian oners of the County Courts shall be allow'd for the defraying of their expences during the time they fhall fit in & attend such Court as aforesaid the sum of eighty pounds of tobacco per day and no more, which fum of eighty pounds of tobacco as aforesaid the faid Comiffic ners of the County Courts are hereby impower'd to assess & levy where fuch Commissioners shall serve as aforesaid for the desiraying the expences aforesaid and no more.

Provided always and it is the true intent & meaning of this Act that where any Justices of any County Court being a full Court or above the number of seven shall agree together in Court sitting and consent to lessen any allowance heroby given (or if it be to take the same totally off) it shall & may be lawful to such sull Court to lessen and take off any part of the allowance hereby given & settled to the Commissioners of the said County Courts and entring such Rule in the Record shall for that Year be an absolute Law & Rule for ev'ry Justice of that County Court as to their expences and it shall not be lawful to collect or raise any more tobacco for desiraying the County Courts Justices expences than so much as by such consent & rule shall be limited and agreed on as aforesaid and if they see sit to make the same Rule or such other as they shall agree on as aforesaid once in every Year any thing herein to the contrary not-withstanding.
