(63)their Stilliards with which they weigh & receive their tobacco to the Standard yearly and every year to be try'd stamp'd & number'd for which they are to pay the person keeping the Standard one Shilling for ev'ry time such stilliards shall be try'd & stamp'd as aforefuld, and every person or persons that shall have their Bushel half Bushel Deck Gallon Pottle Quart & Pint if they make use of the same or any of them in buying or seiling by try'd & stamp'd at the Standard asoresaid except such of the Measures afor faid as come out of England & are there stampt for which they shall pay for the stamping the aforesaid measures six pence a peice.

And whosoever shall presume to fell by any dry measures withour first having the faid measures try'd & stampt at the Standard shall forseit the sum of sive hundred pounds

And whosoever likewise shall presume to weigh and receive tobacco by Stilliards which have not within one year past from such weighing and receiving be a try'd and flamot at the Standard shall forseit one thousand pounds of tobacco the one ballof which forfeitures to be to her Majesty her Heirs & Successors towards the defraying the crarge of the County where the osender shall dwell or reside, and the other half to the informer or informers to be recover'd in any Court of Record of this Province by bill Plaint or Information wherein no Esloyn Protection or Wager of Law to be

And if any person or persons shallresuse to pay any tobacco by such Stilliards try'd & compr as aforefaid and bali thereby compel the owner to have them try'd over again within the Year, if the stilliards are true such person so resulting or compelling as aforefaild all pay for the new tramping, but if not the owners of the Stilliards to pay
