

Bail 72, for every good Behaviour 72, for clearing every Prisoner by Proclamation 80, for the acquittal of every Prisoner 80, for every appeal from the County Court 50, for every Writt of Error return'd from the County Court 50.

To the Clerk of the Council, For every Petition in Council & Order in favour of the party 200 pounds of tobacco, for any Commission or other Instrument prepared by the said Clerk to pass the broad Seal if for a place of profit 400, for every Sheriffs Commission 400, for every Ranger Surveyor or Commission of profit granted in Council 200, for recording any matter in Council *per side* for any private person 24, and so *pro rato* for more or less, for copy of any matter or thing from the Council Records the same *per side*, for all searches to the Clerk of the Council as is to the Honourable Secretary.

To the Clerk of the High Court of Appeals, For recording every Writt of Error *sci-re facias* & return *per side* 24 pounds of tobacco and so *pro rato* as before 7 words in a line and 12 lines in a sheet, the like for recording a Transcript, the like Fees for recording the Errors, for entering & signing Judgment 84, for filing a Bill of cost 24, for copy of the same 24, for all other Fees as are taken in the Provincial Court Office.

To the Clerk of the County Court, For a Writt & return 16 pounds of tobacco, for every Declaration if a side 8 and so *pro rato* if more, for copy of the same if demanded as before, for entering of the Defendants appearance 6, for every impurance 4, for filing every Plea & Demurrer if not a special one 4, if a Folio or more *pro rato* if any copy delivered *pro rato*, for entering any matter upon Record if half a side 4, if more then *pro rato* as before, for a Subpoena if but one name 12, if 2 or 3 names 16, for Rule to plead or Tryal 4, for making up the issue 8, for copy if delivered 8, for entering Judgment 16, for signing Judgment 12, for *venire facias* for Jury 12, for entering the Panel 4, for filing Bill of cost 8, for copy of the same 8, for Execution & Return 16, for special Bail 6, for Writt of inquiry of damages 44, for entering an appeal 8, for the Return of Certificate Copy of the Record *per side* 8, for entering a Writt of Error 8, for every Oath 6, for proving a Deed or Writing 8, for copy of the same if required *per Folio* 8, for recording the mark of Cattle & Hoggs 4, for taking the acknowledgment of Land in Court 12, for recording a Conveyance for Land *per side* 8, for allowance of *habeas corpus* 8, for search every year after the first till 5 years 4 pounds of tobacco *per annum*, and for every year above 5 years 2 pounds of tobacco *per annum*. For Criminals, for taking every Recognizance 14, for discharge of Recognizance 14, for *venire factas* or Warrant 15, for every appearance 8, for every respite or continuance 8, for every order 8, for copy of Recognizance 11, for every Indictment *per side* 8, for copy of the Panel 4, for recording the verdict 8, for entering the Judgment 28, for Execution of the Judgment 23, for Copy Indictment *per Folio* as before 8, for filing a Plea 8, & for confession of Judgment 8.

To the Cryer of the County Court, For swearing every Jury 72 pounds of tobacco for swearing the Bailiff 6, for every Oath 6, for special Bail 36, for good Behaviour 36, for clearing every prisoner by Proclamation or acquittal 40.

And be it further Enacted by the authority aforesaid by & with the advice and consent aforesaid, that the several Naval Officers their sufficient deputy or deputys belonging to the respective Districts next adjoining to the Towns & Ports of Annapolis and Williamstadt shall constantly reside at the said Ports for giving dispatch to all Ships or Vessels trading or coming into them Ports.

And it is hereby further Enacted & Declared by the authority advice and consent aforesaid, that the several & respective Naval Officers of this Province within their several & respective Districts for the several Acts and things relating to their Office by him or them hereby enjoyned to be done shall have and receive the Fees hereafter mentioned and no more (that is to say) for entering any Ship or Vessel coming & trading into this Province being under the burthen of one hundred Tons the Master thereof shall pay unto that respective Naval Officer with whom he shall enter such Ship or Vessel as a Fee for entering thereof the sum of five Shillings and no more and five Shillings more for the clearing thereof, and if such Ship or Vessel shall be above the burthen of one hundred Tons the Master for entry thereof shall pay to the said Naval Officer as a Fee ten Shillings and ten Shillings for the clearing thereof, and the said Naval Officers are hereby obliged to enter all Ships or Vessels of what burthen soever of the build of this Province all whose owners do actually inhabit and reside within this Province & are purchast held & enjoyed by such owners for the sum of two Shillings & six pence Sterling which is hereby allowed and ascertained him as a Fee therefore and for the sum of two Shillings and six pence shall clear the same.

And be it further Enacted by the authority aforesaid that all small Boats belonging to this Province and being under eighteen Foot by the Keel shall pass and repass without
