Horse to be allowed 1909, pounds of rebacen penindath, to a Corner 900 pounds of tobacco per month, to a Quarter-maileibh von pidsios tobacco per month, to a Corporal 700 p'ils of tobacco per mo; to a Trumpeter phospes of tobacco per mo; to every private Trooper 600 pds of cobaco per mon & that alkahese rates & affowalices for such Officers & Soldiers aforesaid shall be allowed & paid & no more and the months before mention'd be accounted computed & reckon'd according to Calender & no otherwise,

And to the intent that whenfoever it shall appear to the Chief Governour of this Pro vince for the time being or his Council to be necellary to raise Forces for the suppresfing of any foreign invalion or domestick insurrection or rebellion or any war with any Indians that the faid Officers & Soldiers, may be duly paid according to the proportions aforesaid and all other charges & expences for the charge & management of such Warr may be duly paid & discharged without which whis Province cannot be desended and secured.

Be it Enacted by the Authority aforesaid that from hencesorth all such necessary charges of fuch Warr and Soldiers pay as aforefaid shall be paid discharged & destray'd by a publick Levy by an equal affeilment upon the Taxables of this Province by the consent of the Freemen of this Province by their Representatives in a General Allembly or out of the publick Treasure of this Province and no otherwise whatsoever.

And to the intent that the inhabitants of this Province may not be abused by having their goods & provisions prest by loose and idle persons who many times abuse their

Commissions and the people,

Be it further Enacted by the authority aforesaid that from henceforth the Commissioners of each respective County shall yearly & every year viz. between the 29th day of September and the 25th day of December nominate & appoint two honest & substantial Men of their Countys to be Preis-masters for the year ensuing, and if any one die or depart the County or be lame or sick within that time that then the next Justice of the Peace to nominate and appoint another in his stead that if occasion require they & no other shall impress victuals and other things given them in charge to be prest by Warrant from his Excellency the Governour in Chief for the time being, and if other but Preis matiers so appointed shall presume upon pretence of any power as a Press. mafier to seize take press or carry away any goods or commoditys of any the inhabitants of this Province shall pay to the person grieved treble the value of the goods or commoditys to as aforefaid unjustly prest. Provided that no Press-master or any perfon or persons whatsoever shall presume at any time to seize press or carry away from the inhabitants residents in this Province any Arms or Ammunition of any kind wharfoever apon any duty or service or upon any account whatsoever under the penalty aforesaid, any Law Statute or Usage to the contrary hereof in any wife notwithstand-

And be it likewise Enacted by the authority aforesaid rhat the Commissioners of any County Court within this Province who shall not between the 27th day of September & the 25th day of December in each respective year by Precept from the County Court figned by the Clerk of the Court nominate and appoint such and so many Press masters for every County as aforefaid shall each of them forfeit & pay unto her Majesty for the support of Government the sum of sive hundred pounds of robace, and such Pressmasters who shall be so nominated & appointed as aforesaid by such Precept as aforefaid to him or them directed and shall thereupon refuse or neglect to serve & truly perform & execute the faid place & office of Preis-malter that forfett & pay unto her, Majesty for support of Government for every time: he on they fo nominated to appointed to shall resuse to serve as asoresaid the sum of five hundred pounds of tobacco.

And for the more and, better incouragement of such Soldiers as male in the fervice of the Country and desence thereof against indians and others, Beit Ena Red by the authority aforelaid that the booty prize pillage or plunder or any Indian or other seized or taken prisoner shall by the Commander be equally distributed & divided among the Soldiers by division or distribution to be made by the tel laway come than it of consell t

And for the incouragement of such Soldiers as shall adventure their lives in the service & desence of this Province and is a the provision of some reasonable provision to be for the suture settled on such Soldiers as shall happen to be maimed or rendred incapable to get a livelyhood for themselves or Family and the reference

Be it Enacted by the authority aforesaid that every person that shall adventure as a Soldier in any Warr or desence of this Province and shall therein happen to be maim'd or receive hurt so as to be rendred incapable of setting a lively hood as a foresaid shall according to his disability receive a yearly pension to be raised our of the publick Leve of this Province for the time being of fuch his disability and every person sain in the
