(72') Arvice of this Province leaving behind him a Wife & children shall also be allowed a competent pension to the Wise during her Widdowhood and the children till they be of years able to get their living or be put out apprentices & that this pension be yearly paid & allow'd out of the fifty thousand pounds of tobacco per annum to be rais'd by the Governour of this Province for the time being or the Council as in this Act is here after provided in the intervals of Assemblys the party petitioning for such pensions & allowances procuring a certificate from the County Court where he she or they live that he the or they are objects of charity and deserve to have such pension & allowance.

And be it further Enacted by the authority aforesaid that if upon any soreign Invasion any perion or persons whatsoever (except before excepted) that shall be prest or be an enlisted Soldier within this Province shall upon the comand of his Officer being a Captein at the least obtainatly refuse to appear and serve in Arms for the necessary desence of this Province such person or persons so obstinatly resuling to appear & serve in arms as asoresaid shall upon certificate thereof under suc 1 Officers hand as asoresaid to the next Justice of the l'eace of the County where such party liveth be proceeded against in manner following (that is to say) the same Justice of Peace to whom such certificate as aforesaid shall be made shall immediatly issue out a Warrant to the Constable of the Hundred where such party liveth to apprehend him and bring him before himself or some other Juilice of the Peace of the same County there to render a sufficient excuse if any he hath for such his resusal or non appearance as aforesaid and if the suffice of i eace shall not find the excuse of such party in such case to be reasonable & sufficient then he shall immediatly commit such person to the custody of the Sherif of such County there to remain until he shall find surety to appear at the next Provincial Court to be held for this Province there to be proceeded against according to due course of Law and if thereupon he shall be convict of such obstinate resusal or disobedience as asoresd he shall be fined & imprisoned according to the directions of the Julices of the Provincial Court. And for the prevention of the great tharges of Annual Assemblys who may meet for no other occasion but to lay the publick Levy in time of peace,

Be it Enacted by the authority aforesaid that the Governour & Council during the intervals of Assemblys for the defraying & payment of the small charges of this Province be and are hereby impowered to assess the same equally to be levyed upon all the inhabitants of this Province for the defraying the faid small charges in time of peace

as aforefaid, any thing in this Act to the contrary notwithstanding.

Provided always, and it is the true intent and meaning of this Act the faid sums for the small charges of this Province so to be assessed by the Governour & Council upon the inhabitants of this Province as aforefaid exceed not in any one year the sum of fifty thousand poends of tobacco & the disbursments of the said tobacco to be accounted for at the next General Assembly after the raising & disbursing the said tobacco as aforesaid.

And be it further Enacted by the authority aforesaid that all Soldiers hereaster to be imployed in any publick service within this Province be paid in the respective Countys where the said Soldiers live. This Act to endure for three Years and to the end of the

next Sellions of Assembly after the end of the said three Years.

An Ad for payment of Fees due from criminal persons. E it Enacted by the Queens most Excellent Majesty by & with the Advice and Consent of her Majesty's Governour Council & Assembly of this Province and the Authority of the same, that from henceforth no Sherif Goaler Clark Cryer or other Officer thall charge either their own County to which they belong or the publick with any Fees for any Criminal committed to the charge of the said Sherif or Goaler having sufficient Estate in this Province wherewith to pay the same or being capable to pay the same by servinge but that such Criminals being discharged by Order & due course of Law shall pay their own Fees to Sherif Goaler Clerk & Cryer and other Officers being such as they may demand according to Law either out of his Estate or by servitude of

Provided always that this Act shall not extend to Malesactors that are executed or to fuch other persons who are banished having no Estate in this Prevince or to servants criminals for whom the County shall pay such Fees as are due by the Acts of Assembly to the Sherit Goaler Clerk Cryer or other Officers of such Court where such criminal shall be convicted. And

Be it further Enacted that all Officers Fees due by Law from criminal servants shall be paid by the County where the fact shall be committed and that all & every such criminal servants for whom the County shall pay the Fees due by Law to such Officers as aforesaid shall after the End and Expiration of his time of servitude to his Master si tissie & pay unto the Commissioners of the County who paid such his Fees sor him to the Sherit and other Officers as aforefaid for the use of the County such sums as the
