have paid as aforefaid, and the feveral Commissioners of the feveral Countys shall and are hereby impowered to make inquisition after all such Servants criminals for whem the Dou my hach decay'd the said sees to the Sheaf & other Officers as aforefaid, and they the said Comi sioners according to their best discretion shall cause to be entred rules for the servants to make such reasonable satisfaction to the County as they shall think sit and in such manner as they shall find convenient and for the better security of the County which hall pay such Fees for such criminal Servants as aforesaid.

Be it Ena ted that the Matter Miltress or Dame of all such servants he & are hereby injoyn'd & required at the expiration of the time of all such servants servicude to such Maler Miltress or Dame to render and deliver up to the Sherif of the County for the use of the County aforesaid such servants criminals as aforesaid under the penaltys to such Maler Miltriss or Dame resulting or neglesting to deliver up such servants as aforesaid of making satisfaction to the County all such sees as by the County aforesaid have been paid for such criminal as aforesaid and such Sherif to whom such criminal tervant hall be delivered as aforesaid is hereby required to receive & secure such services criminals as aforesaid so that he be & appear at the their next County Court to be held for the said County to be disposed of as the said Court shall consider.

An Alt for causing ir and & Petit Jurors & Witnesses to come to the Provincial and County Courts.

E it Enacted by the Queens most Excellent Majesty by & with the Advice and Consent of her Majestys Governour Council & Alsembly of this Province and the Authority of the same, that after the publication hereof the several and respective Sherifs of the several and respective Countys within this Province shall cause to come before the surfaces of the Provincial Court two good & lawful Men of each respective County to serve as grand surors and three good & lawful Men of each respective county to serve as petit surors at every Provincial Court and the said Sherifs shall return Pannels accordingly and twenty days notice shall be given by the Sherifs to the surors before the day of their appearance (Junices of peace and Delegates excepted ) & such Sherifor Sherifs as shall make default shall be fined by the surices of the Provincial Court one shoulful pounds of tobacco to her Majesty for the support of the Government of this Province.

And he it further-Ena Red by the authority aforefaid by & with the advice and confent aforefail that the feveral Sherifs of the feveral & respective Countys aforefail shall cause to come before the subjects of the several County Courts a competent & sufficient number of the best and most understanding Freeholders of their several & respective County Courts and the several Sherifs shall return Pannels accordingly & give notice to such Freeholders ten days before the day of their appearance at the said County Courts, and such Sherif or Sherifs as shall make default shall be fined by the suffices of the County Courts ave hundred pounds of cobacco to her Majesty for the support of the Government of this Province.

And be it further Enasted that every person or persons Freeholders returned by the several Sherits to selve as Jurors at the Provincial Courts and having such notice of the day of his or their appearance as aforesaid and shall not make his appearance at the day but make dastuit shall be fined by the Justices of the Provincial Court one thousand pounds of tobacco and every person or persons Freeholders returned by the several Sheri's to the several Courts to serve as surors at the said County Courts and having such notice of the day of his or their appearance as aforesaid & shall not make his or their appearance at the day but make default shall be fined by the Justices of the County Courts sive hundred pounds of tobacco to her Majesty, both the said Fines to be to her Majesty for the support of the government of this Province.

And be it further Enacted by the authority aforefaid by & with the advice and confent aforefaid that every person that shall be duly served with Process to appear at the Provincial Court as a witness to tellise in any matter or thing there depending & shall not keep his day of appearance but make desault shall be fined by the Judices of the Provincial Court one thousand pounds of tobacco, and every person that shall be duly served with Process to appear in any of the County Courts of this Province as a witness to restific in any matter or thing there depending & shall not keep his day of appearance but shall make desault shall be fined by the Justices of the County Courts sive hundred pounds of tobacco both which Fines shall be to her Majesty for the support of the government of this Province.
