

have paid as aforesaid, and the several Commissioners of the several Countys shall and are hereby empower'd to make inquisition after all such Servants criminals for whom the County hath de'pay'd the said Fees to the Sheriff & other Officers as aforesaid, and they the said Commissioners according to their best discretion shall cause to be entered rules for the Servants to make such reasonable satisfaction to the County as they shall think fit and in such manner as they shall find convenient and for the better security of the County which shall pay such Fees for such criminal Servants as aforesaid.

Be it Enacted that the Master Mistres or Dame of all such servants he & are hereby injoynd & required at the expiration of the time of all such servants servitude to such Master Mistres or Dame to render and deliver up to the Sheriff of the County for the use of the County aforesaid such servants criminals as aforesaid under the penaltys to such Master Mistres or Dame refusing or neglecting to deliver up such servants as aforesaid of making satisfaction to the County all such Fees as by the County aforesaid have been paid for such criminal as aforesaid and such Sheriff to whom such criminal servant shall be delivered as aforesaid is hereby required to receive & secure such servants criminals as aforesaid so that he be & appear at the the next County Court to be held for the said County to be disposed of as the said Court shall consider.

An Act for calling in and ¶ Petit Jurors ¶ Witnesses to come to the Provincial and County Courts.

BE it Enacted by the Queens most Excellent Majesty by & with the Advice and Consent of her Majestys Governour Council & Assembly of this Province and the Authority of the same, that after the publication hereof the several and respective Sherifs of the several and respective Countys within this Province shall cause to come before the Justices of the Provincial Court two good & lawful Men of each respective County to serve as grand Jurors and three good & lawful Men of each respective county to serve as petit jurors at every Provincial Court and the said Sherifs shall return Pannels accordingly and twenty days notice shall be given by the Sherifs to the Jurors before the day of their appearance (Justices of peace and Delegates excepted) & such Sheriff or Sherifs as shall make default shall be fined by the Justices of the Provincial Court one thousand pounds of tobacco to her Majesty for the support of the Government of this Province.

And be it further Enacted by the authority aforesaid by & with the advice and consent aforesaid that the several Sherifs of the several & respective Countys aforesaid shall cause to come before the Justices of the several County Courts a competent & sufficient number of the best and most understanding Freeholders of their several & respective Countys to serve as Jurors of the several & respective County Courts and the several Sherifs shall return Pannels accordingly & give notice to such Freeholders ten days before the day of their appearance at the said County Courts, and such Sheriff or Sherifs as shall make default shall be fined by the Justices of the County Courts five hundred pounds of tobacco to her Majesty for the support of the Government of this Province.

And be it further Enacted that every person or persons Freeholders returned by the several Sherifs to serve as Jurors at the Provincial Courts and having such notice of the day of his or their appearance as aforesaid and shall not make his appearance at the day but make default shall be fined by the Justices of the Provincial Court one thousand pounds of tobacco and every person or persons Freeholders returned by the several Sherifs to the several County Courts to serve as Jurors at the said County Courts and having such notice of the day of his or their appearance as aforesaid & shall not make his or their appearance at the day but make default shall be fined by the Justices of the County Courts five hundred pounds of tobacco to her Majesty, both the said Fines to be to her Majesty for the support of the government of this Province.

And be it further Enacted by the authority aforesaid by & with the advice and consent aforesaid that every person that shall be duly served with Process to appear at the Provincial Court as a witness to testify in any matter or thing there depending & shall not keep his day of appearance but make default shall be fined by the Justices of the Provincial Court one thousand pounds of tobacco, and every person that shall be duly served with Process to appear in any of the County Courts of this Province as a witness to testify in any matter or thing there depending & shall not keep his day of appearance but shall make default shall be fined by the Justices of the County Courts five hundred pounds of tobacco both which Fines shall be to her Majesty for the support of the government of this Province.
