

An Act for the present security of the frontier Plantations from the incursions & violence of Indians, one other Act intituled an Act prohibiting trade with the Indians for any Fiesh dead or alive except Deer & wild Fowle, one other Act intituled an Act for quietting differences that may arise between her Majestys Subjects within this Province and the several Nations of Indians of what places soever, and every clause matter & thing therein contained is hereby declared to be and remain in full force & effect to all intents constructions & purposes whatsoever to the end of the next Sessions of Assembly this present Sessions not having leizure fully to consider thereof.

An Act for suspending the prosecution of any Priests of the Communion of the Church of Rome incurring the penaltys of an Act of Assembly intituled an Act for preventing the growth of Popery by exercising his Function in a private Family of the Roman Communion but in no other case whatsoever.

W Hereas at the Town & Port of *Annapolis* in *Ann-Arundel* County the third Day of *October* 1704 was Enacted an Act to prevent the growth of Popery but forasmuch as the true intent of the said act was only to restrain some exorbitant actions in the said Popish Bishops Priests & Jesuits who it is hoped are thereby made sensible of their extravagant demeanour in their pernicious & indirect practices, It is therefore hereby Enacted & Declared, **And**

Be it Enacted by the Queens most Excellent Majesty by & with the Advice & Consent of her Majestys Governour Council & Assembly of this Province and the Authority of the same, that no Popish Bishop Priest or Jesuit shall by vertue of the said Act of Assembly for or by reason of exercising his Function in a private Family of the Roman Communion be prosecuted or indicted before any her Majestys Justices impowered to hold Plea thereof within this Province until the full end and expiration of the term of eighteen Months from the publication of this Law or until her Majestys pleasure shall be declared therein.

Provided always that this Act nor any thing therein contain'd shall in no wise be construed to extend to defeat rescind abrogate or suspend the Force Vigour or Effect of the said Act for preventing the growth of Popery in any other matter or thing whatsoever or for any longer time than what is in & by this present Act express & declared.

An Act for the division of St. Pauls Parish in Prince Georges County.

An Act declaring an Act intituled an Act for erecting Ann-Arundel & Oxford Towns into Ports & Towns formerly made to be in force.

An Act declaring the Act intituled an Act ascertaining the bounds of Land to be in Force.

An Act declaring an Act intituled an Act for the punishment of persons suborning Witnesses & committing wilful & corrupt perjury to be in force.

An Act declaring an Act intituled an Act for sanctifying and keeping holy the Lords Day commonly called Sunday to be perpetual.

An Act declaring an Act intituled an Act concerning Indians to be in force.

At a Sessions of Assembly begun and held at the Town & Port of *Annapolis* in *Ann-Arundel* County the 15th day of *May* Anno Domini 1705 were Enacted these Laws following.

An Act for the Relief of Ann-Arundel County and all persons concerned in the Records thereof lately burn'd.

W Hereas the Records of *Ann-Arundel* County being lodged in one of the upper Rooms of the publick Court House at *Annapolis* upon the 18th day of *October* 1704 were burned with the said House to the great loss & detriment of the Inhabitants of the said County and all other persons concern'd in the Lands Judgments & Records of & belonging thereunto, For the Redress & Relief whereof it is humbly prayed that it may be Enacted, **And**

Be it Enacted by the Queens most Excellent Majesty by & with the Advice & Consent of her Majestys Governour Council & Assembly of this Province and the Authority of the same, that it shall & may be lawful to his Excellency her Majestys Governour of this Province for the time being by Commission under the great Seal of this Province to Authorize Appoint and Commissionate seven or more discreet & sober Persons whereof any three or more of them from time to time to hear & determine all differences claims & demands whatsoever between any the inhabitants or other persons interested
