At a Sessions of Assembly begun and held at the Town and Port of Arnapolis April the Second and Ended the Nineteenth of the issue Month Anno Domini 1706. In the Fifth Year of the Reign of Our Nich Gracious Sovereign Lady Queen ANNE, &c. His ENCELLENCY JOHNSEYMOUR Esq. being Governour, were Enasted these Laws following viz.

An Alt for Advancement of Trade, and Erelling of Ports and Towns in the Province •JMARYLAND.

EITENACTED by the Queens Most Excellent Majesty by and with the Advice and Consent of Her Majestys Governour Council and Assembly of this Province and the Authority of the same, That stom and after the End of this present Session of Assembly the Towns, Ports and Places herein after mentioned shall be the Ports and places where all Ships and Vessels Trading into this Province shall unlade and put on Shoar all Negroes, Wares, Goods, Merchandizes and Commoditys whatfoever. (that is to fay)

St. Marys County, St. Marys Town, St. Clements Town, & a Town on Beckwich's

Island in Patuxent River.

Kent County, in Chester River on a Plantation of Mr. Joce's, between Mr. Will. mores and Edward Walvins Plantation, in Worten Creek, on a Tract of Land where Francis Barnee lives formerly laid out for a Town, and at Sasafrax River where

Shrewsbury Town was.

Ann-Arundel County, the Town and Port of Annapolis, London Town on the South Side of South River, a Town in West River where the Town was formerly, and ac Herring Creek where the Town was formerly laid out, and a Town to be laid out in Magetty River, on the Plantation late in the possession of Thomas Fianson on the South side of the saidRiver.

In Calvert County, at the head of St. Leonards Creek on both sides of the Mill Branch, at the Mouth of the faid Branch, at the head of Hunting Creek on both fides of the faid Creek, and in the Freihes of Painxent River at the Plantation of George & Thomas Hardisty

In Charles County at Port Tobacco and Newport where Towns were formerly laid out, and at Benedict Leonard Town in Pataxent River where the Town was formerly Erected.

In Baltemore County at Whetstone Neck in Patapsco River, upon the Land called

Chilberry in Bush River, and a Town on Foster Neck on Gunpowser River.

In Somerset County on the North West side of Wiccocomico River on the Woodland Reach below Daniel Hasts Creek, at Rehoboth in Pocomoke River, and at Snow Hill where the Towns were formerly erested, and on a Point of Landlying on the Fork of Monokin River where Capt' Henry Smith formerly lived, some time called White-House, and ar Colebornes Creek in Annamessex.

In Talbot County at Oxford formerly erected into a Port and Town, and at Donca-

ster in Wye River, and at Kings Town in Great Choptank.

In Cæcil County at Capt' Johns Creek where a Town was formerly laid out in Elk

River, and the Landbelonging to Isaac Calk in Saffafrax River.

In Dorchester County at Cambridge in Great Choptank, and at Illington in Little Cheptank, and Little Tarmonth in Transquaking River where Towns were formerly laid out, and at the Emperours Landing in Nanticoke River.

In Prince Georges County at the Land of William Mills in Patuxent River, at Matapany Landing on the Land of Thomas Brook Esq : at Mount Calvert where the Court House stands, and at the upper Landing in the Western Branch commonly called Col' Bells Landing, at the upper Landing in the Northern Branch on the West side of the faid Branch commonly called AnderJous Landing, and at Broad Creek in Potomock River on the South side of the said Creek at Thomas Lewis's Landing.

In Queen Ann's County in Corseca Creek upon the Plantation where Robert Smith Esq! now lives, at Broad Creek on Kent Island where the same Town was formerly laid out.

PORTS. Out of which, the following places and no others shall be and are by this Act reputed and appointed Ports. (.That is to fay ) Annapolis in Ann-Arundel County, St. Marys Town in Potomock, at Chester Town upon Joce's Land in Chester River, Greenhill Town in Somerfet County below Daniel II. fts Creek in Wiccocomico, at the Town of Oxford in Great Chootink, & at Beckwith Mand in Patunent River.

And be it further Enasted by the Authority Advice and Consent aforesaid, that the feveral and respective Persons herein after named, shall be and are hereby appointed Commi signers
