And be it surther Enacted by the Authority Advice & Consent asorcsail, that from and after the first Day of January 1707 aforesaid, all Sherrifs, Clerks of the County Courts, Naval Officers & Collectors, the Lord Baltemore's Collectors & Receivers of his Lordhips-Revenues, shall be & are hereby oblig'd actually to dwell & inhabit in some of the said Ports or Towns, or there keep their sufficient Deputy or Deputy's for the necessary and quick dispatch of all business to their several Offices apportaining & that the Deputy Commissary in each respective County be obliged actually to dwelland inhabit in the most convenient Town or Port in each respective County for the case & conveniency of the Inhabitants thereof.

And for Encouragement of all Tradesmen & Artificers to live & inhabit in the aforefaid Ports or Towns, Be it Enacted by the Authority Advice & Consent as resaid, that all tradesmen & artificers or other persons whatsoever following or using any manual occupation trade or calling in any the ports towns or places aforesaid, & there actually living & residing with their samilys & using their Trades & Callings, shall be and are by Force and Vertue of rhis Act exempted and discharged from paying any Publick or County Levys for themselves Jonrnymen & Servants during the first four Years of their

reliding in fuch Ports or Towns.

And for the better Encouragement of Foreigners or Aliens, Merchants or Tradesmen to come & inhabit in fach Ports or Towns, Be it Enacted by the Authority Advice & Confent aforesaid, that any Alien or Foreigner that shall come & reside in any of the Ports Towns or places aforefaid & there exercise or sollow Merchandize or any Trade or manual occupation for the term of four Years, fuch Alien or Foreigner shall by vertue of such his residence & of this Act be deem'd adjudg'd & accompted to be a free Denizon, & have hold & enjoy all benefits privileges & advantages that any free

Denizon hath or ought to have & enjoy within this Province.

And be it also Enacted by the Authority Advice & Consent asoresid, that the several and respective Justices of the several and respective County Courts within this Frovince, shall from & after the end of this present Sessions of Assembly be obliged to put out all Male Orphan Children Apprentices to some of the Tradesmen and Inhabitants in the faid Ports or Towns (if fuch Tradesmen & Inhabitants can be found & will take fuch Orphans) & not to any other person or persons whatsoever, which said Tradesmen & Inhabitants of Ports & towns shall be subject to the conditions & agreements to be made with them by the Commissioners of the County Courts on behalf of such Male Orphans as other persons that take Orphans have or ought to be, & shall & are hereby obliged to perform the fame.

Be it further Enacted and Declared by the Anthority Advice & Consent aforesaid; that nothing in this Act shall oblige or be construed to oblige any person or persons whatfoever his her or their Heirs or Assigns that formerly hath taken up & built upon any Lot or Lots in the Ports Towns or places aforefaid, by vertue of any former Law or Act of Assembly again or anew to take up such Lot or Lots so as aforesaid sormerly taken up & built upon, but that they their Heirs & Assigns shall & may have hold and

enjoy the same as if this Act had never been made.

And Be it likewise Enacted by the Authority Advice & Consent aforesaid, that any person or persons whatsoever that shall offend act or do contrary to this present Act or the true intent and meaning thereof in any case for which no Fine or Forseiture is before in and by this Act imposed, he she or they so offending shall forseit and pay to cur Sovereign Lady the Queens Majesty her Heirs and Successors the several Sums of Tabacco following (that is to fay ) every Sherif or his deputy five Thouland pounds of Tobacco, every Clerk of the County Court or his deputy five Thousand pounds of Tobacco, every Naval Officer & Collector or their deputys ten Thousand pounds of Tobacco, the Collectors and Receivers of the Lord Balteweres Revenues or their deputys ten Thousand pounds of Tobacco to be recover'd as asoresaid, wherein no Estoyn Prorection or Wager of Law to be allowed.

And be it surther Enacted & Declared by the Authority Advice & Consent asoresaid that if any of the places by this Act appointed for Ports or Towns shall happen to be upon the Dwelling Plantation or Plantations of any person or persons whatsoever whereon there is Erected any Dwelling House or other Houses, or whereon there is planted any Orchard or Garden, and the Lot or Quantity of Ground by this Act allowed to the Owner thereof for his choice will not include such Houses Orchards or Gardens, that then itshall be in the power of the said Commissioners in each respective County or the major part of them, either to allow to such Owner or Owners of such Houses Orchards or Gardens what other or more Recompence or Lotts such Commissioners or the major pare of them, or the Jury aforesaid shall conceive such Houses Orchards or Gardens may be worth over and above the value of the Land so
