At a Sessions of Assembly begun and held at the Town & Port of Annapoles March with and ended April the 15th in the Sixth Year of the Reign of our moit Gracious Sovereign Lady Queen ANNE of England &c. Annoque Domini 1707 were Enacted their Laws following.

A Supplementary All to the All for advancement of Trade and Erecting Ports & Towns. HEREAS several Towns within this Province were ordered and intended to be laid out according to an Act of Assembly of this Province intituled an Act for advancement of Trade and erecting Ports and Towns in the Province of Maryland, made at an Allembly 11.1 (15: begun and held at the Port of Annapalis the 2d day of April 1706, but for several reasons some of the said Towns were not laid out within the time prescribed within the said Act, so that the time being elapsed divers Inhabitants of this Province have petition'd this present General Assembly to have the said Towns revived and others crected.

Be it therefore Enacted by the Queens most Excellent Majesty by and with the Advice and Consent of her Majestys Governour Council & Allembly of this Province and the Authority of the same, that the several & respective Commissioners nominated & appointed in and by the faid Act in their several & respective Countys (except where other Commissioners are by this Act appointed ) shall be and are hereby authorized and impowered to purchase cause to be furvey'd laid out and divided into Lotts the several & respective Lands hereaster in this Act mentioned & appointed for Towns according to the same rules & directions in the said recited Act

contain'd on or before the sirst day of September next (that is to say)

The Land at Benedict-Leonard Town in Charles County by the faid recited Act appointed for a Town, one other one hundred Acres of Land shall be and is by this Act appointed and ere Red into a Town in the faid County lying on the upper fide of Nanjemy Creek on Potomack River upon part of the Land now or late in the possession of Martin Campbel and the Land adjoyning thereto, and also one hundred Acres of Land to be erected into a Town in Somerfet County at a place called Half-round Hill on the South fide of Wiccocomico River, in Prince Georges County a town to be crested on the South fide of Piscattaway Creek at or near the head thereof to contain forty or lifty Acres of Land at the discretion of the said Commissioners for Towns in the faid County, and that three Acres of Land whereon George Harris of Prince. Georges County Merchant hath built dwelling Houses & Store Houses shall from henceforth be adjudg'd accepted reputed and taken to be part of Nottingham Town within the faid County whereunto it adjoyns and shall enjoy all benefits priviledges & advantages to the said Town belonging, in Kent County the place for the Town & Port there by the faid Act erected upon Chester River thall be deserted and in lieu thereof the said Port & Town with the Court-house of the faid County shall be built at the place where the Commissioners for Towns in the said County have purchast land for the same, and that the place appointed for Shrews bury town on En Justial River by the full A & appointed be also deserted & laid out where the Commissioners for Towns in Kent County aforesaid have purchast Land for the same, in Cacil County the place by the faid Act eppointed for a Town on Prices Neck in Elk River where the Courthouse of the said County shall be built, for the building whereof the Commissioners formerly appointed shall have full power to act and proceed as by the Act of Assembly for that purpose made they are impower'd authorized & required, and also fifty Acres of Land more tobe laid out for a Town on the Plantation formerly belonging to Haack Calk near the head of Siffafras River, in Queen Anns County the place appointed for a Town by the said Act on the Land of Rebert Smith Efq! shall be deserted and in lieu thereof one hundred Acres of Land upon the Plantacion of Major John Hawkins in Courseys Creek & the convenient Lands adjoyning thereto shall be ere Red into a Town where the Court-house of the said County stiall be built according to the direction of the Act of Affembly for that purpose made as aforesaid, one other one bundred Acres of Land in the faid County shall & ishereby erested into a Town at the plantatio of Mr. William Sweatnam in Courfival Creek in Chester River, in Dorchester County one hundred. Acres of Land to be crasted and hid out for a Town on a Point called Phillips his Point on the North fide of Fishing Creek in Hangar River and the Town called little Tarmouth in Transquaking River shall be deserted, in Baltemore County the place appointed for a Town 01 Gunpowder River on the Land called Foster's Neck shall be deserted and in lieu thereof fifty Acres of Land shall be ere ted into a Town on a Tract of Land on the faid River belonging to Anne Felks call'd Taylors Choice & that the Court house of the said County shall be built there, in Ann-Arundel County the Towns allotted by the said recited Act to be laid out at Herring Creek to contain fifty Acres and no more, and the Town & Port of Aunapolis with the Town of West River ( which said Town of West River shall contain but sifty Acres of Land ) not being as yet laid our according to the direction of the faid recited Act shall be laid our at the places aforefaid according to the direction of the faid recited Act by the time by this Act appointed, and also that fifty Acres of Land at a placeupon Patuxest River call'd Pig Point skall be and is by this AR allowed for and ere ted into a Town, and also fifty Acres of Land more
