president faid River at a place opposite to Queen Ann's Town in Prince be and is hereby allotted for and crested into a Town, which full Fown than be laid out & divided into Lotts according to the difference of the Commissioners hereafter in this Act for that purpose appointed.

And to that End, Be it Enacted by the authority advice & consent asoresaid, that Mr. Samuel Toung, Mr. Charles Greenberry, Mr. Richard Jones, Mr. Joseph Hill, Mr. Seth Bizes, Mr. Josiah Twogood, Mr. Samuel Chambers, Mr. John Lamb, Mr. William Nicholfon, Mr. Authory Smith, Mr. Thomas Gassaway, Mr. John Battie, Mr. Henry Lazenby, Mr. Jimes Saunders Junior & Mr. Stephen Warman, or any five or more of them shall be and are hereby appointed Commissioners for the laying out of the said Towns & Port and shall be and are by this Act authorized and impower'd to have the same power & authority as the Commissioners in the said recited Act ever had or ought to have; and forasmuch as many persons have taken up lots within the supposed bounds of the Town & Port of Annapolis (since the making of the said reelted-Act) notwithstanding the same was not laid out by the Commissioners according to the direction of the said recited Act, and by such their taking up have ingross'd the greatest part of the Lots within the same Town & Port into very sew hands, to the great discouragement of ioveral Neighbours & others that would build & live therein.

Be it therefore Enacted by the Authority Advice and Consent aforesaid, that if any person whatsoever hath taken up any Lot or Lots within the Town & Port of Annapolis since the time of the making of the faid recited Act, such taking up shall not give any Right or Title to such taker up his heirs or assigns, bur that such Lot or Lots so taken up shall be free to be taken up. again by any persons that will take up and build upon the same according to the direction of this and the said recited Act in as sull & ample manner to all intents & purposes as it the same

had never been taken up.

And forasmuch as the Land allotted for the Town & Port of Oxford in Talbot County by the first laying out of the same Town did contain 124 Acres, but by the said recited A I made Anno 1706 there is no more allotted for the same than 100 Acres of Land. Be it therefore En-Enacted that the Town & Port of Oxford shall on or before the first day of September next com ing be by the Commissioners nominated & appointed in the said recited Act surveyed and said out according to the former Platt, and when so laid out the Commissioners according to their discretion shall leave out 24 Acres of Land from the said 124 Acres, and the Lots remaining within the 100 Acres onlyshall be adjudg'd the Town & Port of Oxford, altho' the same do not contain 100 Acres Lots, to the end that the Lots already taken up and built upon may not be alter'd or lessen'd'

And forasmuch as divers of the Inhabitants of this Province who would build and fettle in Towns, and to that end have taken up Lots in the Towns laid out by the Commi sioners of the several Countys pursuant to the said recited Act, but for want of nails to build their houses with by the time in the faid recited Act allotted for building thereof are apprehensive or fearful of loling their Lots already taken up as aforefaid and others kept from taking up Lots, for

prevention whereof & incouraging the building & fettling in the full lowers,

Be it Enacted that if any person or persons that already have or that hereaster shall take up anyLot or Lots within any such Town or Towns laid out as aforesaid within this Province by vertue of the faid recited A&, he she or they so taking up such Lot or Lots and creating building & finishing one good house that shall contain sour hundred square Feet of ground besides Shedds spon every such Lot so taken up or to be taken up as aforesaid on or before th first day of September which shall be in the Year of our Lord 1708 shall by vertue of such taking up & building have hold & injoy to him and his heirs for ever a good Estate of Inheritance in Fee Simple of in and to the said Lot so built upon as aforesaid with all rights & priviledges thereto belonging in as large and ample manner to all intents & purposes as if the same had been built upon within the time appointed by the said recited Act, any thing in the said Act to the contrary notwithstanding.

And be it suther Enacted by the authority advice & consent aforesaid, that if any Town of Towns within this Province other or more than what is exprest in this Act and by the said recirculact appointed to be laid out for Towns by the time in the said recited Act mentioned have not as yet been laid out accordingly, that the several and respective persons appointed Constillioners in and by the said recited Act in the several & respective Country of this Province that have the same power & authority to purchase lay out and divide into Lors the severat purcos of Land appointed for Towns as aforefaid in as full and beneficial manner to all intents of purposes as they had by vertue of the said recited A. provided such sowns be laid out by the first day of September 1707. And the all Tobacco & Merchandizes of the growth

& production of this Province may be brought only to those Ports or Towns.

Be it Enacted by the authority advice & consent aforesaid, that all Tobacco & other Mereliandizes of the growth & production of this Province deligned to be exported out of this Province by Landor Water (except Timber, Dipestaves, Billets & Wooden Ware) shall after the sentil day of September which shall be in the Yoar of our Lord 1703 for that end be brought
