(104) to be forfeited by the high Sherif if he wilfully refuse to make the thereof to her Majesty her Heirs and Seccessors for the support of governtile energy ball to the party grieved, to be recover d by action of debt in any Court of record or this Province; which certificate to obtain'd, any friend or agent of such prisoner shall frew to such next Justice of peace, and if such friend or agent will aver that the prisoner hath tobacco ready to pay such debt or damages recover'd convenient, and that such friend will open and shew the same, the said Justice of peace shall either go in person or send two discrect persons sworn before him to view the tobacco and weigh it and make report thereof, and if it happen the tobacco is tound merchantable and of such weight to discharge the whole sum mention'd in the Execution, then shall the said Justice give notice to the Sherif in writing under the hand of fuch Juliece by the agent of fuch prisoner, that except such Sheriscome and shew good cause to the contrary that the said Justice will cause the said tobacco to be markt on the creditors risque, and if cause be not shew'd within forty eight hours after the date of such writing, which shall be dated on or at a certain hour of a certain day, that then the Justice shall cause the said tobacco to be markt and numbred, and shall send the Sheris a certificate of the mark number weight and place where such tobacco lyes on the creditors account, and in case the prisoner is not in his custody on any other account, he shall suffer him (paying or giving security for his Fees) to go at large, and shall not be answerable upon any action of escape, and if after this the Sherif detain the prisoner any longer in prison, such detaining shall be adjudged false imprisonment. This Act to endure three Years or the end of the next SeAons of Assembly which shall happen after the faid three Years.

An All for the killing Wolves & Crows. E it Enacted by the Queens most Excellent Majesty by and with the Advice and Consent of her Majestys Governour Council & Assembly of this Procince and the Authority of the same, that hereafter for incouragement of the inhabitants of this Province her Majestys Sub jects their Servants & Slaves to take some pains and make it their business to destroy Wolves, that the sum of three hundred pounds of tobacco be allow'd to every such inhabitant that shall bring a Wolf's head to any Justice of peace in that County Levy where the Wolf was kill'd, pro vided that he that brings it shall before he have certificate thereof make Oath that he himself or some other of her Majestys Subjects their Servants or Slaves and not any Indian did kill the

fame in that County, and the Justice of peace shall cause the tongue to be cut out that it may not be presented again.

And if any Indian bring a Wolf's head to any Justice of peace he shall have for his farisfaction two hundred pounds of tobacco, which shall be satisfied out of the County Levy where the Wolf was kill'd, and every Justice of peace is required to make the incouragement allow'd the

Indians as effectual as he can.

And if any of her Majestys Subjects bring a Wolfs head and will not mobile of the thir ic was · kill'd by themselves or some other of her Majestys Subjects their Servantion Slaves as a oresid

he shall have but two hundred pounds of tobacco.

And for ev'ry Crows head that shall be brought to any Justice of peace there shall be paid to the person bringing the same six pounds of tobacco according to the direction of the late Act of Assembly for killing of Wolves & Crows. This Act to endure for three Years and to the end of the next Seffions of Assembly after the end of the said three Years.

An All reviving a certain Act of Affembly of this Province intituled an All prohibiting the importation of Bread Beer Flower Wheat or other English or Indian Grain or Mea', Horses Mares Colts or Filleys from Pensitvania and the Territorys thereunto belonging, made at a Sessian of Assembly begun & held at the Port of Annapolis the 5th day of September 1704.

E it Enacted by the Queens most Excellent Majesty by & with the Advice & Consent of her Majestys Governour Louncil & Assembly of this Province and the Authority of the same, that the above mention'd Act prohibiting the importation of Bread, Beer, Flower, Wheat or other English or Indian Grain or Meal, Horses, Mares, Colts or Filleys from Penfilvania and the Territorys thereunto belonging, and every thing article & clause therein contained be and is hereby revived & continued in full force & strength from and after this present Sesfion of Assembly for and during three Years and to the end of the next Session of Assembly that shall first happen after three Years.

An All reviving an Act for speedy conveying publick Letters & Pacquets of this Province & defraying the charge thereof, made at a Session of Assembly begun and held at the Port of Annapolis the 5th day of September 1704.

E it Enacted by the Queens most Excellent Majesty by & with the Advice & Consent of her Majestys Governour Council & Assembly of this Province and the Authority of the fame, that the abovemention'd Act for speedy conveying publick Letters & Pacquets of this Province and defraying the charge thereof, and every thing article & clause therein contain'd be and is hereby revived & continued in full force & strength from and after this present Session of Assembly for and during three Years and to the end of the Session of Assembly that shall first happen after three Years. r Ost 🙀
