

loss and hindrance that the party which procured the nonappearance of the said Witness or Witnesses shall be liable to pay several Sums to be set off against the offender or offenders by Action of Debt Bill Plaint or in any of their Majesty's Courts of Record in this Province, upon no Entry of Protection or Wager of Law to be allowed.

*An Act for the Outlawing of Richard Clark of Ann-Arundel County.*

**W**HEREAS it appears to this General Assembly upon Oath that *Richard Clark* of Ann-Arundel County and his Accomlices, do seize upon the Magazine, and his family, the Governour, and overturn her Majesty's Government and to bring the Heavens together with the Conspirators to cut off and extirpate the inhabitants of this Province, and inasmuch as the said *Clark* flies from Justice and dares not venture himself upon a fair Tryal, Be it therefore Enacted by the Queens most Excellent Majesty by and with the Advice and Consent of her Majesty's Governour Council and Assembly of this Province, and the Authority of the same, that unless the said *Richard Clark* do within twenty Days after the End of this present Session of Assembly surrender himself to his Excellency the Governour, or to any one of her Majesty's honourable Council in order to be tryed for his Treason aforesaid, that then the said *Richard Clark* by Force and Vertue of this Act shall be Outlawed, and shall forfeit his Goods and Chattels Lands and Tenements as an Outlawed Person, any want of Process or any other legal Proceedings in any wise notwithstanding.
