

An Act prohibiting the Importation of  
 bread Beer Flower Maile Wheat or other Indian  
 or English grain or Meale Horse Hares Tolls  
 or Tills from Pennsylvania and the Territories  
 thereto belonging

Be it Enacted by the King most Excellent  
 Majesty by and with the Advice and Consent of his  
 Majesty's Governour Council and Assembly of this  
 Province and the Authority of the same that from  
 and after the end of this session of Assembly it shall  
 not be lawfull for any person or persons whatsoever  
 to Import or Cause to be Imported from the Province  
 of Pennsylvania or the Territories thereto belonging  
 or from any other plantation or Province or Colony  
 in this Continent in America into any port of  
 this Province by Land or by Water any quantity or  
 quantity of Bread Beer Flower Maile Wheat or  
 other English or Indian grain or Meale Horse or  
 Horse Hares or Hares nor any Tolls Tills or Tolls  
 Except Tolls from Virginia to this place for Landing  
 Ships on pain and penalty that whosoever shall  
 Import contrary to this Act any the King's goods shall  
 loose and forfeit the same one halfe to his Majesty  
 his heirs and Successors for the support of the  
 Governour of this Province the other halfe to him
