of the same whereby they may be seized

And be it further enacted by the autho-
rity aforesaid and with the Advice and Consent aforesaid that
every Justice of Peace within his jurisdiction in
his proper County And every Sheriff Officer and Collector
in or out of his District And every Constable or Constables
in his or their So And every two hundred and every
Church Warden or Church Wardens in his or their So
and respective Parishes by virtue of their Offices and
that they may lawfully seize such goods and things
as they find imported contrary to this Act And if any
private person being one of the Officers aforesaid shall
discover any such goods or things so unlawfully
imported he shall inform the next Justice of the
Peace who is hereby enjoined and commanded under
the penalty of five thousand pounds of To be
forfeited to the Use aforesaid to direct a precept to the
next Constable or Constables of such Hundred where
such things are supposed to be concealed thereby
commanding at the request of such Informer to
make search for such things as are so unlawfully
imported where such Informer shall direct and
the same having found to seize and secure for
the Use of His Majesty and Informer aforesaid and the
same to keep for ten days in which time of
