for their own use only and not to be sold for Sale nor  
to any other use that shall remove them either  
into this province with their Families in Order to  
sell them nor to furnish any of His Majesty's  
of War in purchasing or supporting bread  
Flour or any manner of English or French  
Grain towards the supplying their said  
and not otherwise any thing in this part but to  
the contrary notwithstanding

And also for repealing a Law made  
at a Session of Parliament in the first  
Year of His Majesty's said Majesty's  
and also for repealing the Oath of  
Allegiance to be taken in this Province

Forasmuch as the pretended Prince of Wales  
hall for some time and doth continue to pretend to  
himself the Title of King of England and the  
Dominions thereto belonging by the Name of  
James the third therefore for the better Security  
of His Majesty in his just rights and Sovereignty  
in and over the Province of Maryland and  
for extinguishing all hopes of the Friends and
