be admitted to the Execution of that Office — 11

But forasmuch as by the Death of the most
Sacred Majesty King William the Third the Subscrib-
ing the said Association is not necessary to be
longer continued —

It is therefore enacted
that such part thereof and Clause in the before
recited Act of Assembly which relates to the
Saying of the said Association and
no more is hereby repealed and Declared void

And it is further enacted by the
Authority and consent of that all and every Person
and Persons that are at this present time Persons
men in this province and all other Person or Persons
that for the time to come shall be elected or chosen
Persons shall take the before recited Oath
of Allegiance and that it be administered
unto them according to the forms and methods
prescribed in the act of Assembly for taking
the oath of Allegiance required to be taken and after
the taking such Oath they shall be elected or
chosen shall be deemed and taken as one of
the Persons and not before.
