

18 Provided always that because there is not for  
Doubt now not to be had in the province or  
Transcribing the Acts of this present session to be  
sent to the Court that for this session only good  
Paper shall be accepted to transcribe the said Acts  
therein

And be it further enacted by the  
Authority aforesaid with the Advice and Consent  
aforesaid that all the Acts of Assembly which shall be made  
in this present session and all the succeeding sessions  
of Assembly shall within ten days after the end of  
each session be transmitted into the Secretaries  
Office and the Secretary for the time being shall  
upon receipt of the said Acts into his Office cause  
the said Acts to be entered upon Record in a very  
fair legible hand and in a good substantial book  
bound with leather or parchment cover with large  
Margins and also Alphabet the said book in good  
Order and Affix the seal of his Office thereto  
and the Clerk or Clerks that do record the said Acts  
shall make oath before the Governor of this pro-  
vince for the time being or before one of his  
Majesty's Council or two of the Justices of the  
provincial Court that he or they have carefully  
examined the records of the said Acts by the  
Original Acts which have passed the great
