

the time of their laying the County Levy to his Majesty
his heirs and assigns for the War against Spain of
forfeiting double the sume for every such Officer or Person
received and not accounted for and paid as aforesaid to be
levied as the Justices of such County Court shall Direct

And forasmuch as there is but little money in the
County of this Province and that it will be extremely
difficult to levy and collect the fines imposed by this
Act for the greater ease of the Magistrate or other Offi-
cers Obliged to execute the powers and Authorities
herein contained it shall and may be lawfull for
such Magistrate or other Officers as aforesaid where money is
not to be had and the persons forfeiting the same are
freeholders or settled residents within any County in
this Province at their discretion either to levy the
same according to the directions of this Act or other-
wise to receive a sum of such Officer or Officers
and fines thereupon arising and returne the
same yearly to the County Justices of November
fourth Under such Magistrate or Officers hand and
seal of which amount the said County Courts shall
cause their Clerks to give a fair Copy to the Sherif of
the County in order to collect such fines and for-
feitures and upon refusal of payment hereof
the Sherif is hereby Impowered to Levy the same by
way of Execution in to be at one penny & a pound
