a leather or parchment cover which said books shall be lodged
with the Clerk of the County which said lands as aforesaid
and kept among the Records of the said County which
said bounds so ascertained and entered as aforesaid shall be
and remaine the certain and undoubted bounds of the
said lands forever. And further the said Com-
missioners after having ascertained the limits and
bounds as aforesaid shall and may by virtue of this Act put
either the Complainant or Defendant (as the Law shall
require) into peaceable possession of the bounds so de-
termined and also Assess and Pierce all Costs and
Damages arising therein upon non payment where-
of it shall and may be lawfull for the party or parties
concerned to bring an action at the Common Law for re-
covery thereof And to give such Order or Decree in evidence
to prove the same in which action no Justice protection
or wages of Law shall be allowed and that from all and
every of such Decrees and Determinations there shall
be no appeal or review other then is hereafter expressed

And be it further Enacted by
the Authority aforesaid that such Commissioners so commis-
sioned as aforesaid in consideration of their time and trouble
in viewing the said Lands in controversy as aforesaid and
passing such Order and Decrees as aforesaid shall for
every day they attend thereon be paid the sum of
