a leather or parchment cover wherewithal said books shall be bound
with the paper of the County wherewithal said books are affixed
and kept among the records of the said County which
said bounds so fastened and putred as aforesaid shall be
and remaine the certaine and undoubted bounds of the
said bookes forever. And further the said Com-
missioners after having ascertained the summe and
bounds as aforesaid and may by the value of this Act put
either the Complainant or Defendant (in the case of a fine
require) into peaceable possession of the boundes so de-
termined and also Assess and Decree all costs and charges
Damages arising thereupon upon non payment where-
of fit shall and may be lawfull for the party or parties
concerned to bring a suit at the Common Law for revo-
very thereof And to give such Order or Decree in evidence
to prove the same in which action no cross protection
or wager of law shall be allowed and that from all and
every of such Decrees and Determinations thereshall
be no Appeal or review otherwise than as hereafter specified

And be it further Enacted by
the Authority aforesaid that such Commissioners so com-
missioned as aforesaid in consideration of their time and trouble
in viewing the several books mentioned aforesaid and
passing such Orders and Decrees as aforesaid shall for
today day when they attend theron be paid the sume of
