

thereof as aforesaid shall be no further review or appeal<sup>73</sup>  
whatsoever allowed to any of the Courts of this province

But in case the pretensions of any party grieved shall  
amount unto or be adjudged to exceed the value of three  
hundred pound. It is that then and in all such cases such  
party may have an appeal from such sentence of the  
Commissioners of Review to the Kings Majesty in Council  
by giving security to prosecute such appeal with effect  
or otherwise pay and satisfy all such cost and Damages  
as shall or may come to the other party for whom  
such sentence has been given by making such his  
appeal as aforesaid

Provided nevertheless and it is hereby enacted  
and Declared that the party for whom such sen-  
-tence aforesaid shall be given shall not anyway be  
Delayed by such appeals to the Kings Majesty as aforesaid  
but immediately put into possession of the Land within  
the bounds so ascertained as aforesaid and also provided  
that where any bounds of Lands have been already  
settled and Determination by any Law suits Arbitra-  
-tions or otherwise such Determination appearing upon  
Record the same so settled and Determined shall remain  
and continue unalterable and no way subject to any  
View or review of the Commissioners appointed by this  
Law and that it shall and may be lawful for the  
provincial Court of this province to hear and Determine
