

84 shall and may be lawful to and for such Vestry men
to apply the said forty pounds of £ 40. for the
building of a new work and if Pitt hath or shall so long
by reason of a long vacancy in such parish that
there shall be no occasion to apply the said £ 40. to
the use of or of any such £ 40. after such application
hath or shall remain in the hands of the Vestry
the said Vestry are hereby directed and Impowered to
Purchase therewith either a plantation with a
tract of Land or a certain tract of Land as near and
contiguous to the Church belonging to such parish
as may be (and if there be no Church in such pa-
-rish then to purchase a tract of Land as may be
most convenient for the Inhabitants there of and
build a Church thereon) which plantation or
Land shall be and forever remain as a glebe
to the use of the Ministers of such parish for the
time being who shall be lawfully Inducted and
appointed according to the usage of the Churches
of England and this proviso and if there shall
happen in any parish to be £ 40. over and above
answering the tax it shall be employed to
the Improvement and Stocking such Glebe as the
Vestry shall Judge most proper And forasmuch
as by the said recited Act there is nothing Allowed
to the Rector in collecting the said forty pounds of £
