

84 shall and may be lawfull to and for such Vestrymen
to apply the said yearly pounds of £100. aforesaid for the
building of Bancwark and if Pitt balls or shall so happen
by reason of a long Vacancy infallit permit that -
where shall be no occasion to apply the said £100. to
the leasaff or of any. such £100. after such application
shall or shall remaine in the hands of the Vestry
the aid Vestry akeably directed and impowered to
Purchase therewith either a plantation with a
tract of land or a certaine tract of land as hee and
Contiguous to the church belonging to such parishes
as may be found in the church in such pa-
rishes thereto purchase a tract of land as may be
most convenient for the inhabitannts thereto and
build a church thereon whiche plantation or
land shall be and forever remaine as a Glebe
to the uses of the Ministers of such parishes for the
time being who shall be akeably Inducted and
Appointed according to the usage of the Church
of England and this province and if their shall
appen in any parish to be £100. over and above
answering the twyng it shall be empoyed to
the Improvement and Stocking fules Glebe as the
Vestry shall Judge most proper And forasmuch
as by the said recited all there is nothing allowed
to the Rector for collecting the said yearly pounds of
