

86 any Sheriff for Seizing or marking any kind or kinds of
Tobacco containing more than what is lawfully Due for
Scays and dues aforesaid without Satisfaction to the
person to whom such Tobacco belongs as by his
owing Credit or suffering him to take the Currer up
out of such kind of Tobacco at the time of the party pay-
ing or owing the same shall pay for every such Defaut
the sum of two thousand pounds of Tobacco which the
King in Majestey his Heires and Successors for support of
Government the other half to the party received to
be recovered in any Court of Record of this Province
by action of Tobt Bill plaint or Information when
there is no Sposee protection or warrant of Law to be had

And if it shall so happen that at any time
any Sheriff shall seize any kind of Tobacco which
shall weigh more than such Scayes or dues as
aforesaid amount unto of the remaining part due
to the party or parties from whence they shall re-
ceive such Scayes or dues as aforesaid to the greater
Quantity then and in Every such Case the Sheriff or
Sheriffes shall take out of the said kind such Quantity
or Quantities of Tobacco due to him for such Scayes or
dues as aforesaid and the said kind and the remain-
ing part of the Tobacco shall be and remaine with the
party or parties paying the same but of the re-
maining part of such kind of Tobacco so seized as aforesaid
