 province as aforesaid the Commissioners of the county
 courts shall be allowed for the defraying their expenses
 during the time they shall sit and attend such court
 as at the sum of eighty pounds of Tobacco and no
 more which sum of eighty pounds of Tobacco the
 Commissioners of the county courts are hereby empowered
 to receive and pay on the taxable persons of the several
 counties which said counties shall live as aforesaid for the
 defraying the expenses aforesaid and no more

 =ables and what shall be taken of them and what pay-

Be it Enacted by the King
 most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and
 consent of his Majesty's Council in and assem-
 bly of this province and the authority of the same
 that the Justice of Peace in every respective County
 of this province at the first County Court next after
 the first of Michaelmas shall appoint Constables in each
