

to found provisions at the charge of this Province to be
 paid by the publick and if it shall happen that any
 Troopers have been killed in the service then the said
 Troop to be paid for the same by the publick and
 not otherwise

And that all persons in holy
 Orders Deacons Magistrates and Constables shall in their
 proper persons be exempted from being transported to
 Muster and Train either in house or field during such
 time as they officiate in their respective offices as aforesaid

Provided that this Lawe shall not extend to such
 persons as already have or shall hereafter accept of
 Commission for Military service from the Governour
 of this Province or the Lieutenant Governour or discharge
 such persons from their respective charges mentioned in
 such their Commissions and respective Commissions

And be it enacted by the Author

ity of the said Governour and Lieutenant Governour shall
 be exempted the Duty of Training within Military
 service that they pay for the Officers and Soldiers of
 the said and some of said other that is hereafter
 mentioned as follows to wit the Officers
 and Soldiers that shall be in service by the said
 foot ten thousand of five months to twenty
 pound a month of five hundred pound of
 five months to a Major of foot twelve hundred
 pound of five months to a Capt of foot one thousand
