

And be it further enacted
 that if any free Town or Villages shall harbour
 or entertain any such person or persons as aforesaid
 and if they be offending shall forfeit and
 pay as aforesaid for every such offence the sum of one
 thousand pounds of lawful money to our Sovereign
 and the King his heirs and successors for the use of the
 Treasury or the other half to the party grieved to
 be recovered as aforesaid and if any such offending Town
 or Villages shall not be able sufficient where with
 immediately to satisfy and pay such penalty as aforesaid
 it shall and may be lawful for the Justices before
 whom such matter is tried to order satisfaction by
 seizure or otherwise as to them shall seeme meet

And for the better discovery of Runaways

Be it hereby further enacted by the
 Authority aforesaid and consent aforesaid that any person or persons
 whatsoever within this Province travelling out of the
 County where he lies or they shall ride or live without a
 pass under the seal of the said County for which they are
 to pay ten pounds of lawful money or one shilling in money, such
 person or persons if apprehended not being sufficiently
 known or able to give a good account of themselves shall
 be left to the Discretion and Judgment of such Magis-
 trates before whom such person or persons as aforesaid shall
