

shall be brought to Judge the Court and if before such time
quitrate such person or persons so taken up shall be deemed
and taken as a Runaway or Runaway the same or they shall
suffer such fines and penalties as are hereby provided
against Runaways. — And for the better Encouragm^t
Hall show to seize and take up such Runaways.

It is hereby further Enacted by the
Authority above and Consent of that all and every such
person or persons as a^t seizing or taking up such Runaway
travelling without Paper as a^t not being able to give
a sufficient Account of themselves as a^t shall have
and receive two hundred pounds of ~~to~~ to be paid by
the Owner of such Runaway servant Negro or slave
so apprehended and taken up and if such suspected
Runaway or Runaway be not servant and refuse to
pay the same he she or they shall make Satisfaction
by Scutledge or otherwise as the Justice of the Provincial
and County Courts where such person shall be so appre-
hended and taken up shall think fit. — And
for the better Discovery of and Management of our
Wandering Indians to seize apprehend or take up any
Runaway servants or slaves and bring them before a
Magistrate they shall for reward have a matchcoat
paid him or them or the Value thereof which said re-
ward shall be paid and satisfied by the County where
such person shall be so apprehended and such Runaway
