

13. Except those which came but five years since of such  
servants being the said servants into the respective County Courts  
where they do inhabit and every of the said Courts are  
herby authorized to judge and determine of the right  
and service of the said servants and cause the same to be tried  
upon Record and to say upon Neglecting as aforesaid  
fussing to bring such servants before the Court as  
aforesaid shall not only stand to the determination of the  
Court but also for the time of one thousand five  
hundred and thirty six the King his heirs and successors for the support  
of the Government and if any Master or servant aforesaid  
with the determination of the Court shall within the  
time determined for their service produce an authentic  
Cert. of such servants and shall have remedy to the aforesaid  
mentioned ages and forasmuch as Disputes have  
seriously arose at what time for times of servitude  
whether by Judgment or otherwise should continue

Be it enacted by the Authority aforesaid  
and consent aforesaid that all servants transported into  
this Province whether by Judgment or otherwise and  
for ever hereafter adjudged as aforesaid shall continue  
of servitude from the first Anchoring of their Vessel  
within this Province — provided that the said Vessel  
carry not above for ten days after their entry within  
the Capes and the first Anchorage within this Pro-  
vince and all the day full ships shall carry  
in Virginia above fourteen days shall be adjudged
