

As judged part of the service of such servant which shall be  
afterward brought into Maryland and there. But any  
law wage or custom to the contrary notwithstanding.

And be it also enacted by  
the Authority above and consent of that very Justice  
made by any servant during the time of his  
service by Justice Justice or Judgment of the County Court  
according to the tenor of this Act shall be void and not  
in any way oblige any servant for any time then by  
his said Justice or Judgment of the Court shall be  
revoked and appointed

And be it further enacted  
by the Authority above and consent of that for all  
such runaway servants or slaves that shall be  
apprehended and taken up in the province of Pennil-  
vania or colony of Virginia and from thence brought into  
this province and delivered into a Magistrate of the  
County into which they shall be brought the person or  
persons shall have paid and allowed him by the Master  
or owner of such runaway four hundred pounds of Tobacco  
and Cash or forty shillings in money upon his producing  
a certificate from the Justice or Just of the Delivery of such  
runaway except servants or runaway brought from  
Annamock into Somerset County for such only two hun-  
dred pounds of Tobacco or twenty shillings. And the like
