

any Matter or thing whatsoever which shal be sued or prosecuted
 to Judgment in any of the Courts of Record Chancery Com-
 mons and Admiralty Courts within this province
 at any time or times from the Death of our late Majesty
 James the first of blessed Memory to the end of this present
 year; notwithstanding the Demise of the said
 Queen or the want of any Jurisdiction or Authority in
 the said Court: shall be good and effectual in law to all
 intents constructions and purposes whatsoever

Provided always that this Act nor any thing
 therein contained shall not be construed to extend to take
 away any Power which shall or may lawfully be
 exercised by any Justice of the Peace or any other
 Magistrate in any County or Burgh or Town or Village
 or Hamlet or Precinct or Parishes or Townships or
 of Judgment in point of Law in all such cases the
 parties concerned may have their writs or writs of Error
 upon the same Proceedings Judgments or Verdicts as they might have had
 before the making of this Act

An Act for settling the height of
